**Re: *Subpoena Duces Tecum to Olympus Power, LLC***

Dear Mr. Garrett:

This Firm represents Olympus Power, LLC. Our client has asked us to respond to the subpoena served on it at its offices in New Jersey, where it is operating as an essential business under New Jersey law during the COVID-19 Pandemic.

We first wish to express our client's dismay that your process server determined to enter its office space and wander around looking for someone without an appointment, without knocking, and without any prior notice. As everyone knows, conditions in New Jersey mandate extreme precautions to protect essential workers like the employees of our client who were on site and the presence of a stranger walking around the office was quite unsettling.

With respect to the subpoena, and without waiving any rights including, without limitation, objection to the authority of the City of Jacksonville to compel a response, I advise you that after a good faith search, Olympus Power, LLC has no documents responsive to either paragraph 1 or paragraph 2 of the subpoena.
