



Race Route:

- Start at Bay Street near Marsh Street.
- West on E. Bay Street to N. Liberty Street
- South on Newnan Street to Independent Dr.
- Right on E Independent Dr.
- Enter Main Street Bridge using exit ramp
- Cross Main Street Bridge to Southbank and exit onto Riverplace Blvd.
- Left on Riverplace Blvd. to traffic circle.
- Round traffic circle to head South on San Marco Blvd.
- San Marco Blvd. to Mary Street.
- Right onto Mary Street to the Acosta Bridge.
- Exit Acosta Bridge onto Water Street.
- East on Water Street to Pearl Street.
- South on Pearl Street to the riverwalk.
- Follow the riverwalk past the landing/Hyatt to Market Street.
- North on Market Street to Bay Street.
- East on Bay Street, finish near Marsh Street
