Dear Mr. Holland,

Pursuant to City Charter Section 18.05 (k), an ad hoc committee consisting of Council Auditor Kirk A. Sherman (Chair), Council Member Bill Gulliford, Deputy General Counsel Peggy Sidman, Chief Financial Officer Ronnie Belton and Supervisor of Elections Jerry Holland met this morning to prepare a financial impact estimate of the change described in a City Charter amendment straw ballot referendum to be held on the March 24, 2015 Election as approved by Ordinance 2014-151-E and subsequently clarified by Ordinance 2014-681-E.

The clarified straw ballot referendum question addressed by the financial impact estimate is as follows.

"Should the City of Jacksonville City Council support and enact legislation to require that all City employees, appointees, employees of independent agencies (not including Duval County School Board), and employees of constitutional officers hired after January 1, 2016, reside within the boundaries of Duval County during the term of their employment or appointment?"

The ad hoc committee unanimously adopted the following financial impact estimate after discussing estimated changes in City of Jacksonville revenues and costs.

"This straw ballot, if implemented, will have a minimal impact on revenues and costs for the City of Jacksonville."

I thank the committee members and staff for their participation in the creation of this statement.
