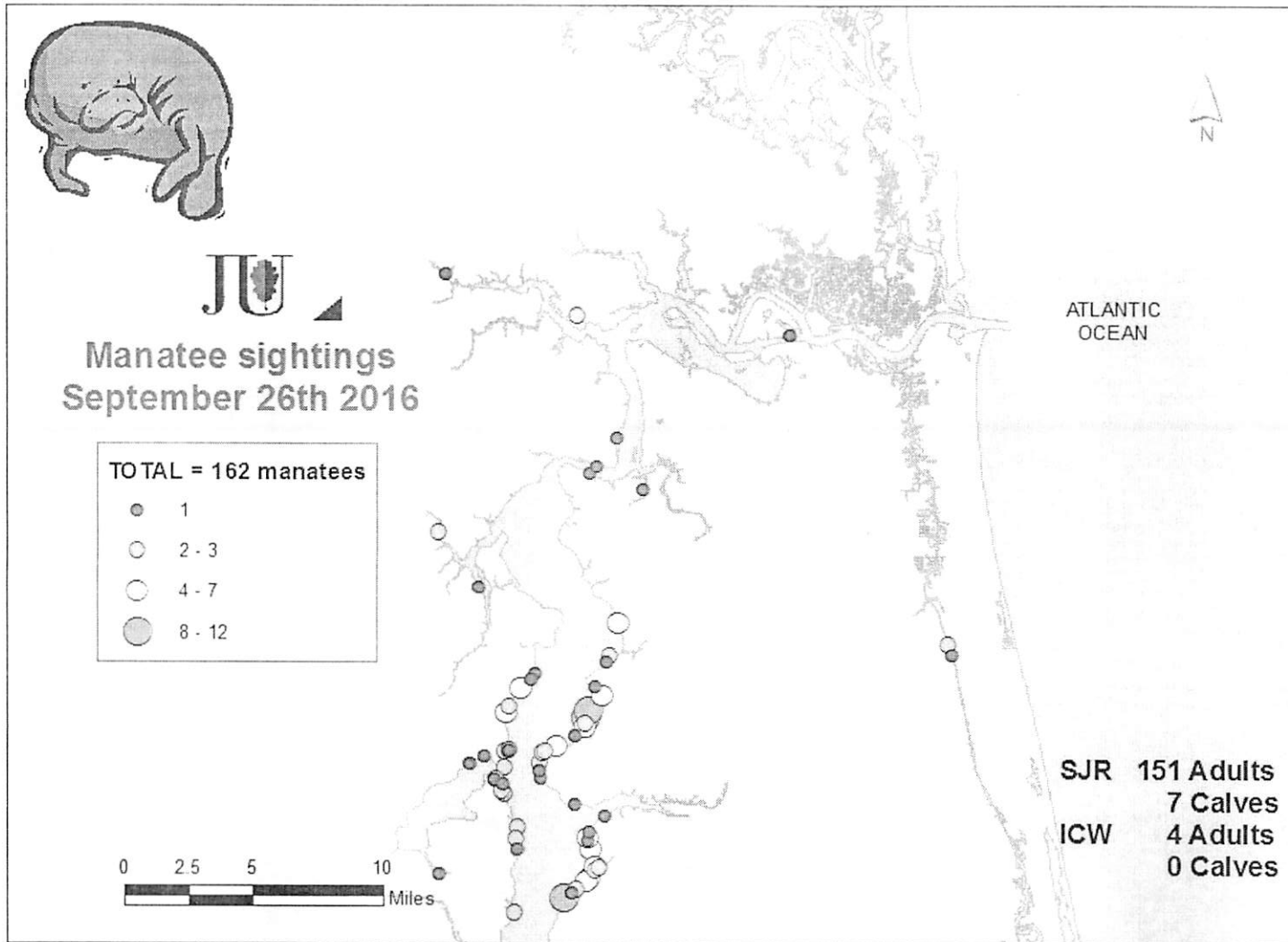

The information contained in this email and the manatee sighting maps are the results of aerial surveys conducted by Jacksonville University under an agreement with USCG AIRAUX. The manatee sightings represent the known minimum number of animals and their location at the time of the flight. The numbers may be higher and the animals change locations frequently. The information is an indication of the number and the location of manatees and subject to change daily.
