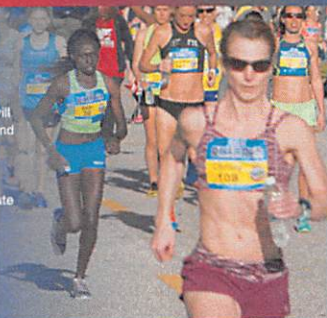
#### Gate RiverRun
