


Big and Little Fishweir Creeks: potential public access opportunities


Currently, there are no designated, public waterway access points along either creek. The map below shows two sites with limited potential.



Option 1: Big Fishweir Creek @ intersection of Merrimac Ave and Fair Street. The ROW touches the creek adjacent to JEA utility box. There is one parking space/driveway in front of the JEA gate plus a private business in close proximity. Need to determine if parking could be established in the ROW or get permission to use JEA property or partner with adjacent business (AutoQuotes, Inc). See site photos below.

Land slopes steep, then gradual from street to creek. View of creek from shoreline.

Option 2: Little Fishweir Creek @ Greenwood Ave. The ROW abuts the creek and surrounded by residential. Existing bridges don't allow paddling upstream from this location. No onsite parking unless allowed on-street. Appears difficult to create parking within ROW. Tree/vegetation blockages downstream from site would need to be cleared to make navigable. Unsure if water depths are sufficient for paddlers. Shoreline slope is gradual but soft. See site photos below.
