Caveats and considerations for "Power Purchasing"

1. No local preference for federally funded solicitations

Title 2 CFR 200.319(b) prohibits the use of statutorily or admininstratively imposed state, local, or

tribal geographical preferences in the evaluation of bids or proposals.

2. Differing JSEB/DBE/M/WBE utilization programs

Programs are not the same for each agency and would have to be addressed in any cooperative purchasing

3. Standardization

There are differences in the agencies of standards in the various products and services and these will have to be addressed.

4. Local vs State, Federal and National Cooperative Purchases

Must be a balance between the competing interests of contracting locally and obtaining the best value, local cooperative purchasing efforts cannot compete with the pricing that results from ultizing contract awards that are competitively procured by state, federal and national entities.

5. Bundling for "Power Purchasing" vs. Unbundling for Small Business Opportunities COJ's recent Disparity Study includes a recommendation for "unbundling" or breaking large procurements into smaller contract awards to create more opportunities for our ever-increasing local small business community.

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
