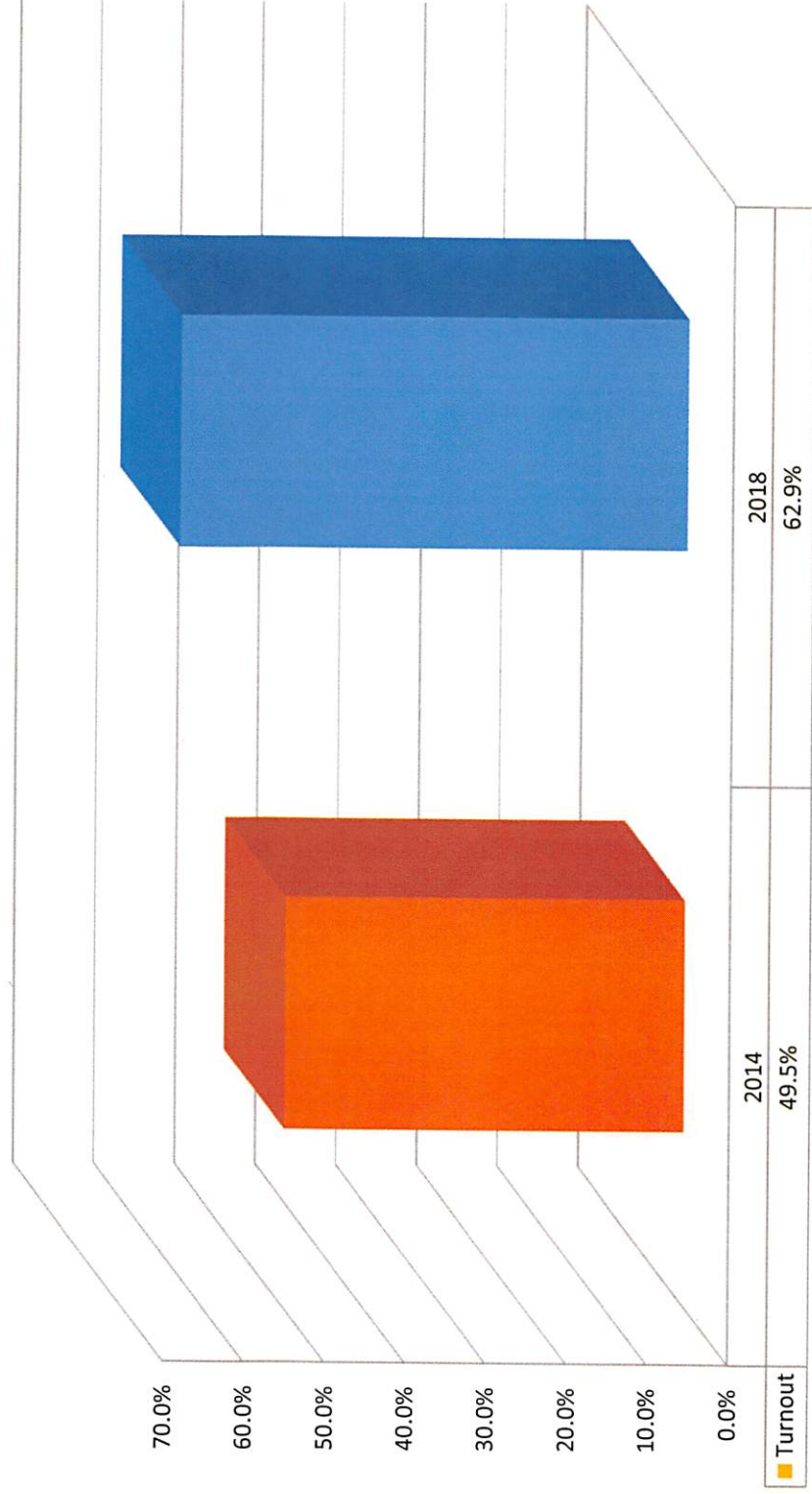

Comparing the 2014 and 2018 Midterm Elections

- ✓ Voter registration increased 10% or by 55,222 voters.
- ✓ Voter turnout increased by 108,413 or 39.6% over the 2014 General Election.
- ✓ Voters casting ballots on Election Day fell from 53% in 2014 to 40% in 2018.
- ✓ Political Party Share of registered voters was almost identical for both Midterms.

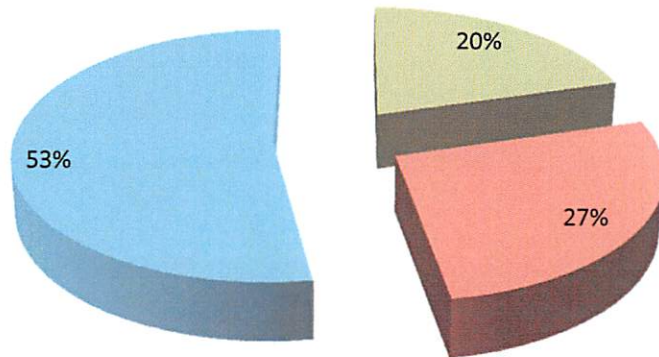

Voting Method 2014 General

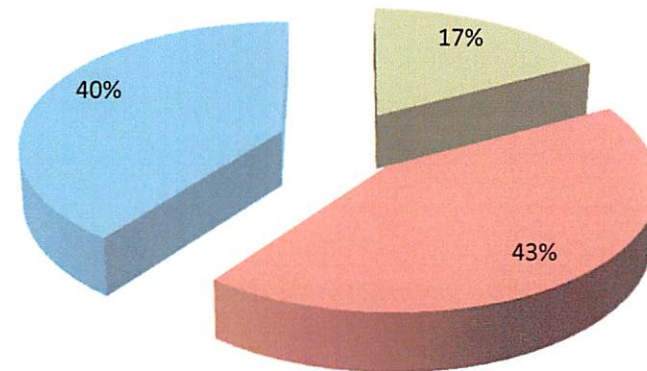

Voting Method 2018 General

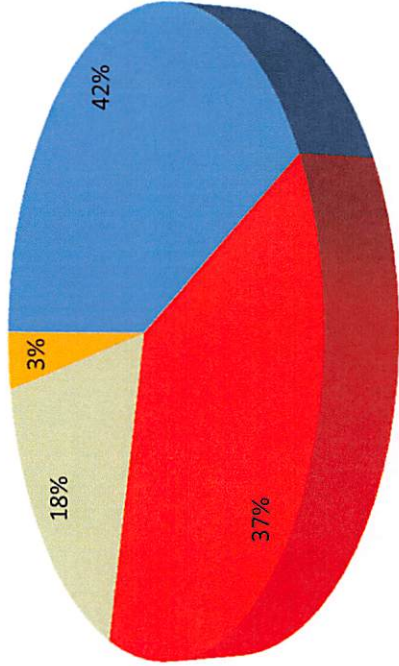

Political Party Share

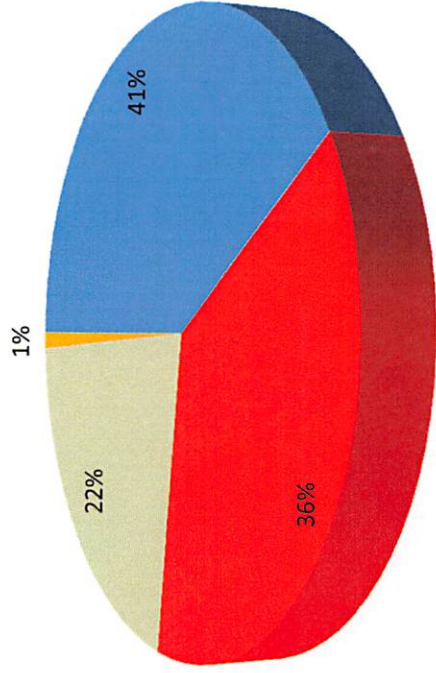
2014 Party Share

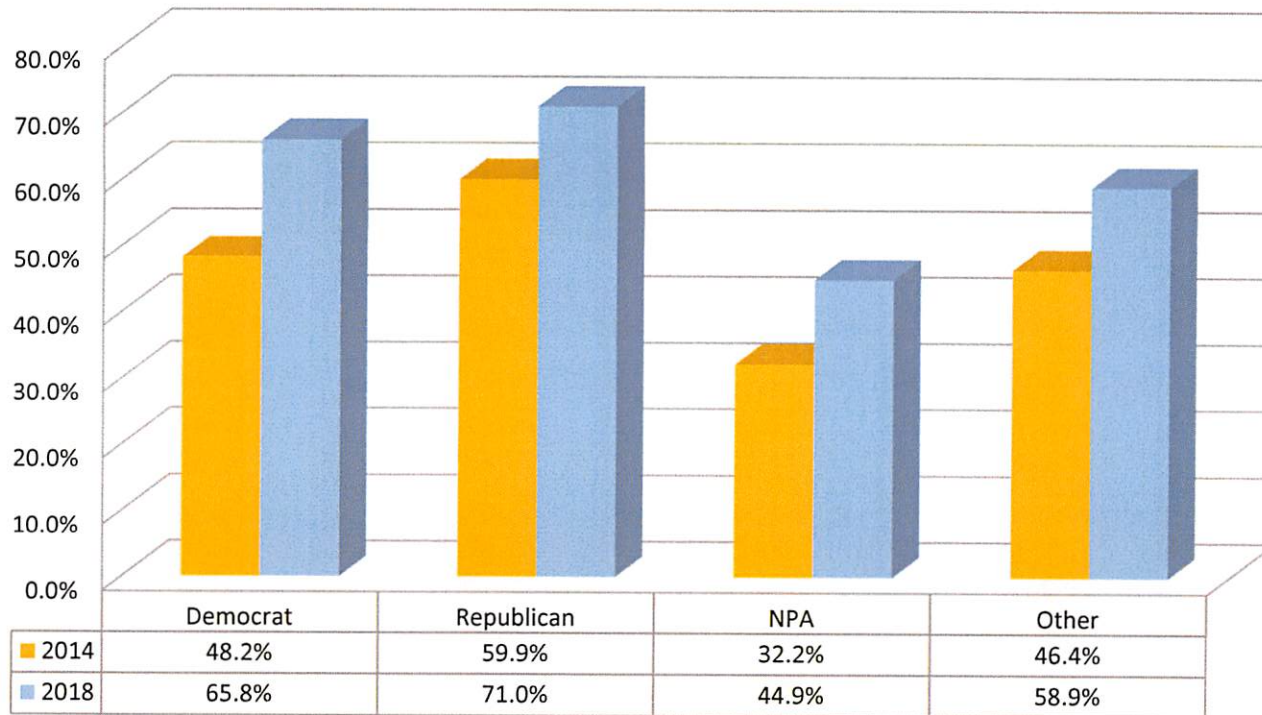
2018 Party Share

Party Turnout %

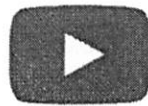

Florida election recount: Examining vanishing votes in machine recount

Supervisor of Elections Susan Bucher talks about ballot recount

As Florida suffered through nearly two weeks of election counts and recounts, the scale of the vote-tallying woes in some places became painfully evident.

Three of Florida's four largest counties — Broward, Palm Beach and Hillsborough — admitted to problems in their machine recounts so troubling that they either failed or refused to submit results by the state's deadline.

And little wonder.

During the statewide machine recount, the number of votes counted in the Senate race in Broward County was 3,500 less than the initial tally.

Among the culprits: the county elections office's accidental omission of 2,000 early-voting ballots in the machine recount.

In Palm Beach, elections officials conducting the recount found "dozens of precincts missing a significant number" of votes, something that county Elections Supervisor Susan Bucher blamed on malfunctioning vote-counting machines.

That prompted a time-consuming redo, which Bucher said caused her office to fail to meet the deadline for the Senate race. Saddled with tabulating machines that could not recount more than one race at a time, she did not even begin the recount for the other races, making hers the only office in Florida to fail to complete its machine recount in the five days allowed.

The other two, Broward and Hillsborough, finished the recount on time but didn't make the deadline for other reasons.

Most of Florida's 67 counties have far fewer ballots to count. Union County, for example, had 5,000. Palm Beach County had nearly 600,000.

In Hillsborough, which had the fourth-largest vote total at 521,000, elections officials were so unnerved by an 846-vote drop in the recount that they refused to submit their results to the state, even though they finished with time to spare.

For the big dip in the vote totals, Hillsborough's Elections Supervisor Craig Latimer blamed power outages and the loss of a voting machine, The Miami Herald reported.

"Even though we achieved 99.84 percent success in our recount effort, we are not willing to accept that votes go unreported," Latimer told The New York Times.

Broward finished 15 minutes before the deadline but took 17 minutes to transmit the information to the state. State officials rejected Broward's two-minute late submission and the exact figures from that machine recount were not available for this analysis.

And Broward, unlike Hillsborough, had no qualms about submitting a recount with thousands of fewer ballots in the Senate race. After the recount, Broward Supervisor of Elections Brenda Snipes resigned.

No surprise

The headline of The New York Times story said it all: "Nearly 3,000 Votes Disappeared From Florida's Recount. That's Not Supposed to Happen."

In theory, a recount should turn up the same number of votes as the first count, since both counting efforts review the same set of ballots. Ballots rejected by the machines are only tallied if a manual recount becomes necessary.

But the machines that scan and tally the millions of marked ballots cast in each statewide election inevitably read some ballots differently the second time around.

Michael T. Morley, an assistant professor of law at Florida State University, told The Herald that high-speed vote-tabulation machines can wear out and become uncalibrated after extensive use, causing them to stop counting properly.

Add to that the inevitable errors made by often-undertrained and overworked elections workers as they collect and store ballots, and it's little surprise that numbers tend to vary.

Near flawless recounts

But not all counties had such significant problems.

While just one of the 20 largest counties in the state reported the exact same vote tally in both an initial count and machine recount, several counties came extremely close, a Palm Beach Post analysis found.

In the Senate race, the county with the smallest relative difference between its preliminary count and its machine recount was Seminole County.

Of more than 198,000 votes cast, the Central Florida county reported a difference of just one vote between the two counts.

In the governor's race, Pinellas County reported the smallest relative difference. Of more than 435,000 votes cast, the initial count and recount differed by only three votes.

Brevard County, meanwhile, logged the only perfect score among the 20 counties with the largest voting tallies, reporting the exact same number of votes — 276,132 — in both the initial count and the recount of the agriculture commissioner race.

Consistent Duval

Yet when it came to consistency, the standout was Duval County, which had the state's second-lowest relative difference in vote totals in all three races.

In the Senate recount, the difference in Duval between the initial vote tally and the recount was just two votes out of more than 378,000 cast.

In the governor race, the difference was four votes. In the agriculture commissioner race, just a single vote separated the two counts.

To underscore how fragile the vote-counting process is, though, consider that even Duval's recount wasn't free of technical problems.

The county's initial recount found a 39-vote discrepancy in the number of votes cast, alarming the county's canvassing board.

So elections workers redid the recount. Focusing on ballots cast on Election Day, they were able to resolve the issue.

"We didn't like being 39 votes off," County Judge Brent Shore, the canvassing board's chairman, told the Florida Times-Union.

Officials blamed the initial discrepancy on mechanical problems in the office's vote-counting equipment, the newspaper reported.

Among the 20 biggest counties, excluding Broward, the county with the highest percentage of change in all three races was Collier. The biggest shift there came in the governor's race, where 110 votes of 155,500 vanished.
