1940-1950: The fifth major wave of immigration, primarily from Southern and Eastern Europe. This period saw the arrival of many immigrants from Italy, Poland, and Greece.

1950-1960: The sixth major wave of immigration, primarily from Southern and Eastern Europe. This period saw the arrival of many immigrants from Italy, Poland, and Greece.

1960-1970: The seventh major wave of immigration, primarily from Southern and Eastern Europe. This period saw the arrival of many immigrants from Italy, Poland, and Greece.
