

## Urban Core (Health Zone 1) Demographics

### Source

2013-2017 American Community Survey 5-Year Estimates, U.S. Census

### Methodology

Compiling this demographic data was a multistep process. Typically, gathering data via the U.S. Census is done on the county level. In this particular case, data was only needed for a specific area within Duval County: The Urban Core (The zip codes in Health Zone 1). Unfortunately, the U.S. Census does not have counties broken down into districts or specific areas outside of census tracts and certain subdivisions. To find the data specifically for the Urban Core, the Zip Codes that lay within Duval County Health Zone 1's borders were used. There are 6 Zip Codes within Health Zone 1: 32202, 32204, 32206, 32208, 32209, 32254. To get the demographic data for the Urban Core, data was gathered from all 6 Zip Codes and combined to get total figures.

### Table Breakdown

There are multiple tables housing all of the demographic information for the Urban Core gathered in this dataset. These tables include the data for each individual Zip Code as well as the totals which represent the data for the entire Urban Core.
