1. What do you think the ideal membership size of the Strategic Planning Commission should be?
2. Should the Strategic Planning Commission be composed of representatives of City Government and its agencies or the public, or some combination thereof?
3. Who should appoint the members of the Strategic Planning Commission? Should the City Council and Mayor both have appointments?
4. Should appointees represent segments of the community and, if so, which segments?
5. What should be the term of office of Commission members and how can their independence be assured?
6. For how long should the Strategic Plan be established and how often revisited?
7. How do you enforce adherence to the Strategic Plan?
8. How do you enforce engagement and cooperation of the Legislative and Executive branches of the government as well as the various city agencies, including the Sheriff?
9. Should the staffing of the Commission be wholly independent of the Executive or Legislative branches?
