I understand that tickets to the TPC have been distributed directly to the Council Members. You need to check on the value of these gifts, as if they are valued in excess of \$100, you may have to pay that excess amount yourself.

We are checking with the Council Auditor on the contracts between TPC and the City.

Gifts should typically come into the Council President's office and be distributed by him—that way, you are receiving a gift from the City, and not the vendor/contractor directly.

We will update you on the law that applies when we get info from the Council Auditor's office.
