

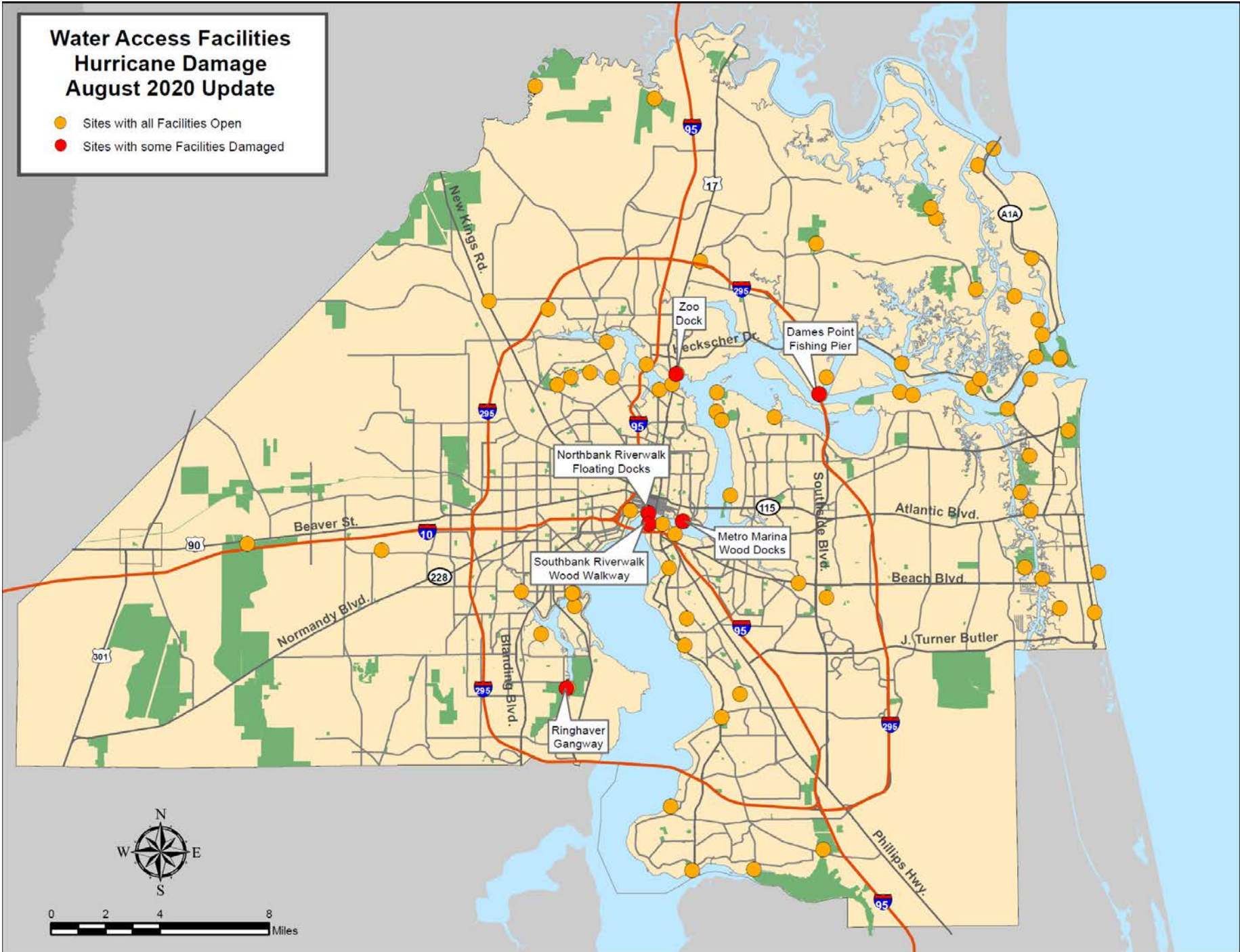

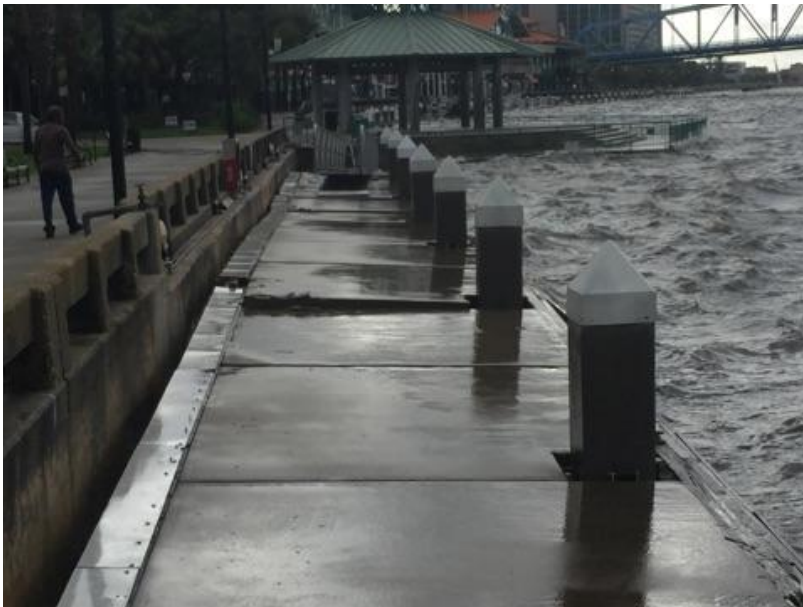
Hurricane Matthew Damage: Arlington Lions Club/Blue Cypress Boardwalk

- Project complete.



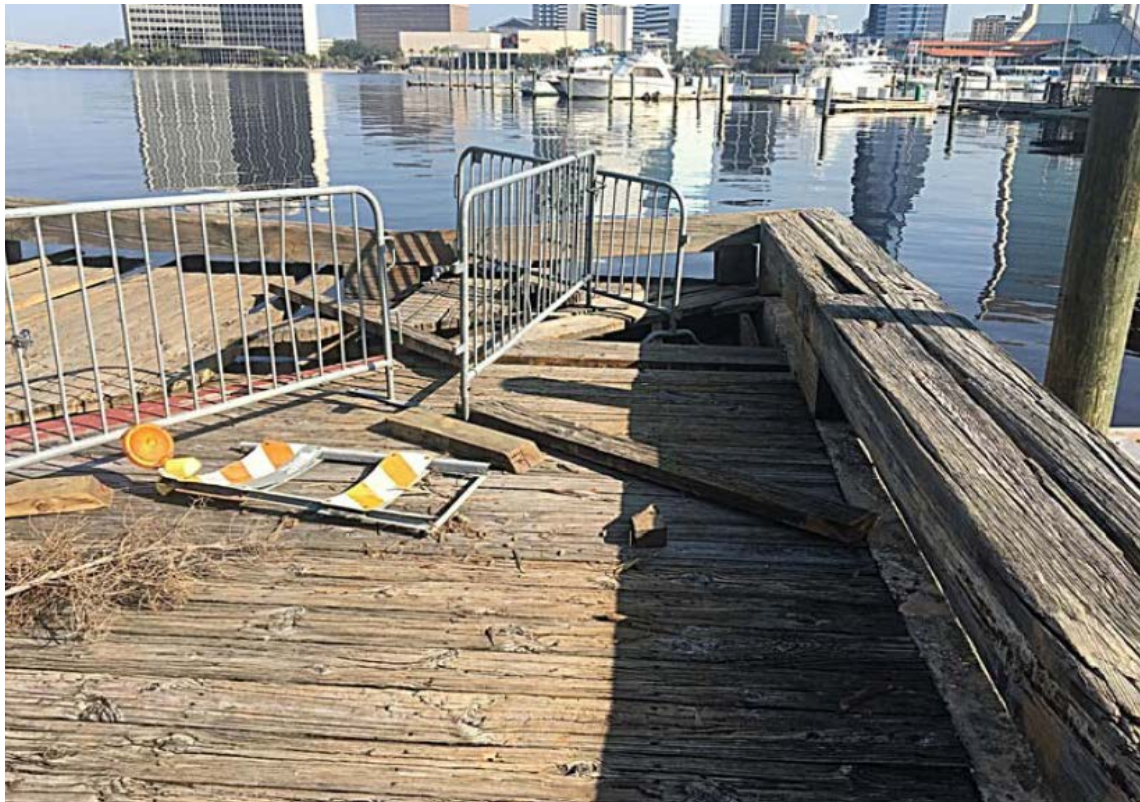
Hurricane Matthew Damage: Northbank Riverwalk – Floating Docks

- 90% Design complete to repair fishing pier.
- Advertise in Fall 2020; construct in 2021.



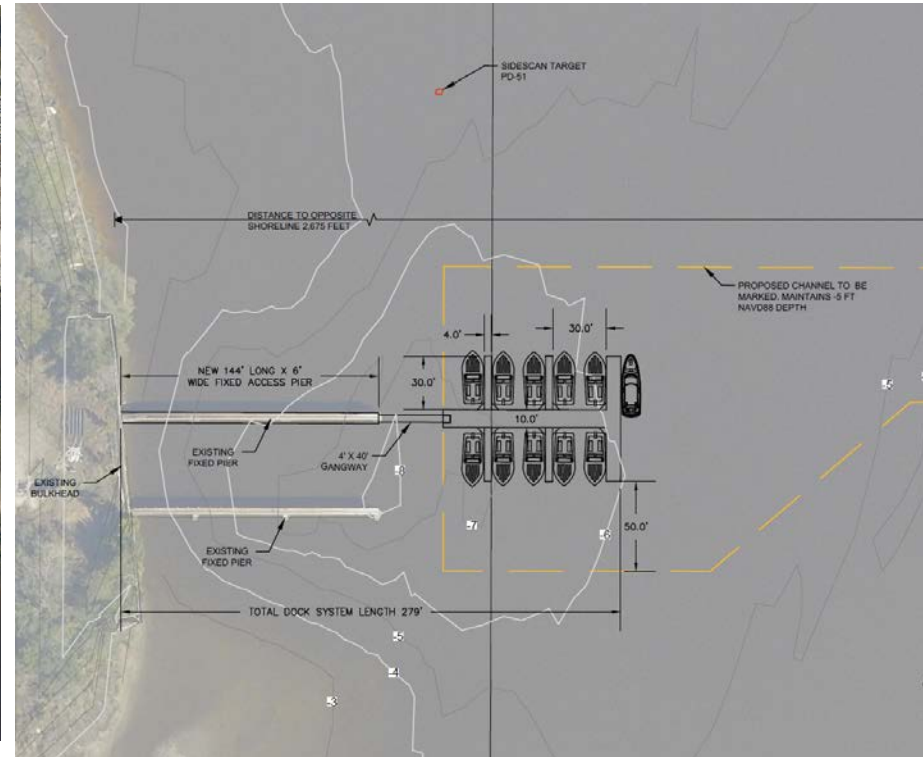
Hurricane Irma Damage: Ringhaver Park – Gangway & Floating Dock

- 2020 FIND grant application.

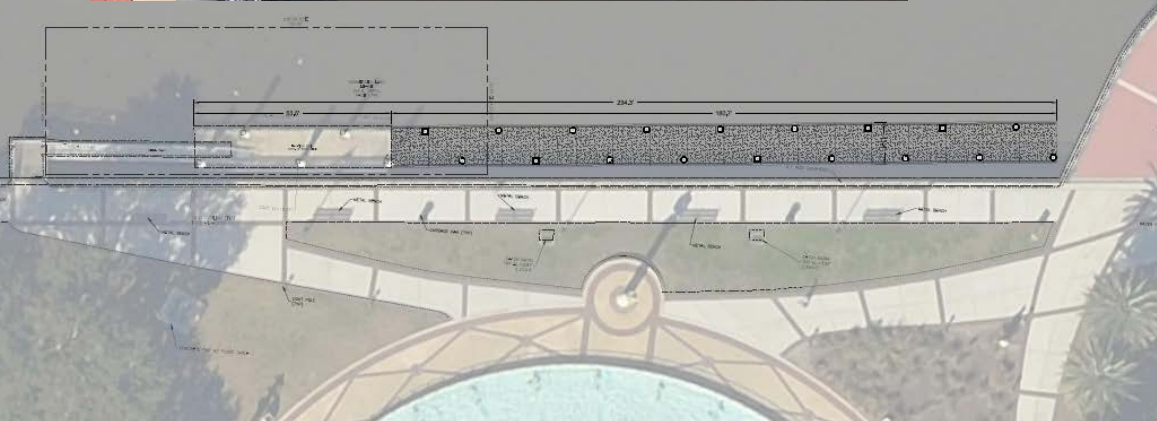

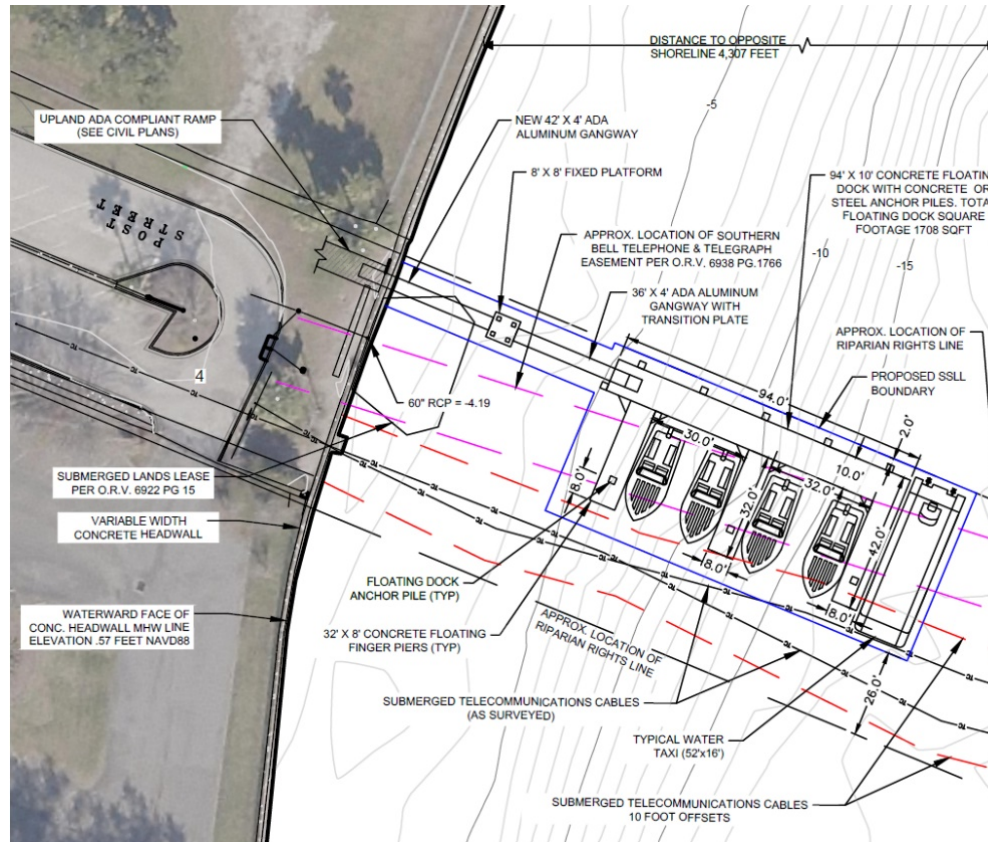
Friendship Fountain – 180' Dock Extension

- Under construction; complete in Aug. 2020.



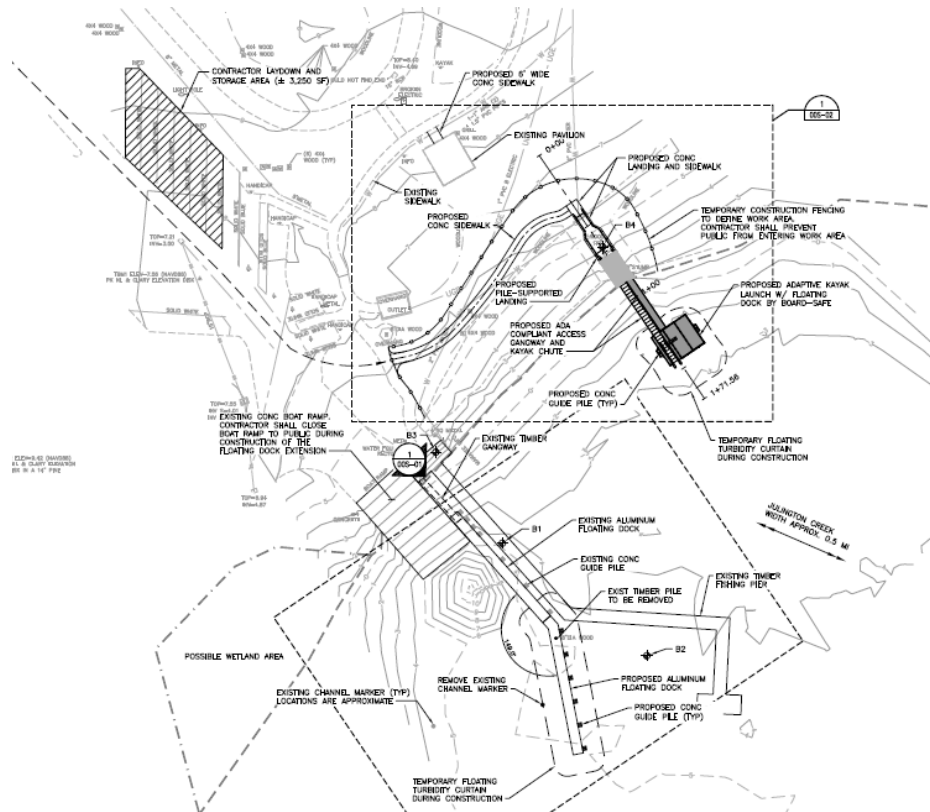
Post Street – New Floating Dock

- Anticipate construction in 2021.



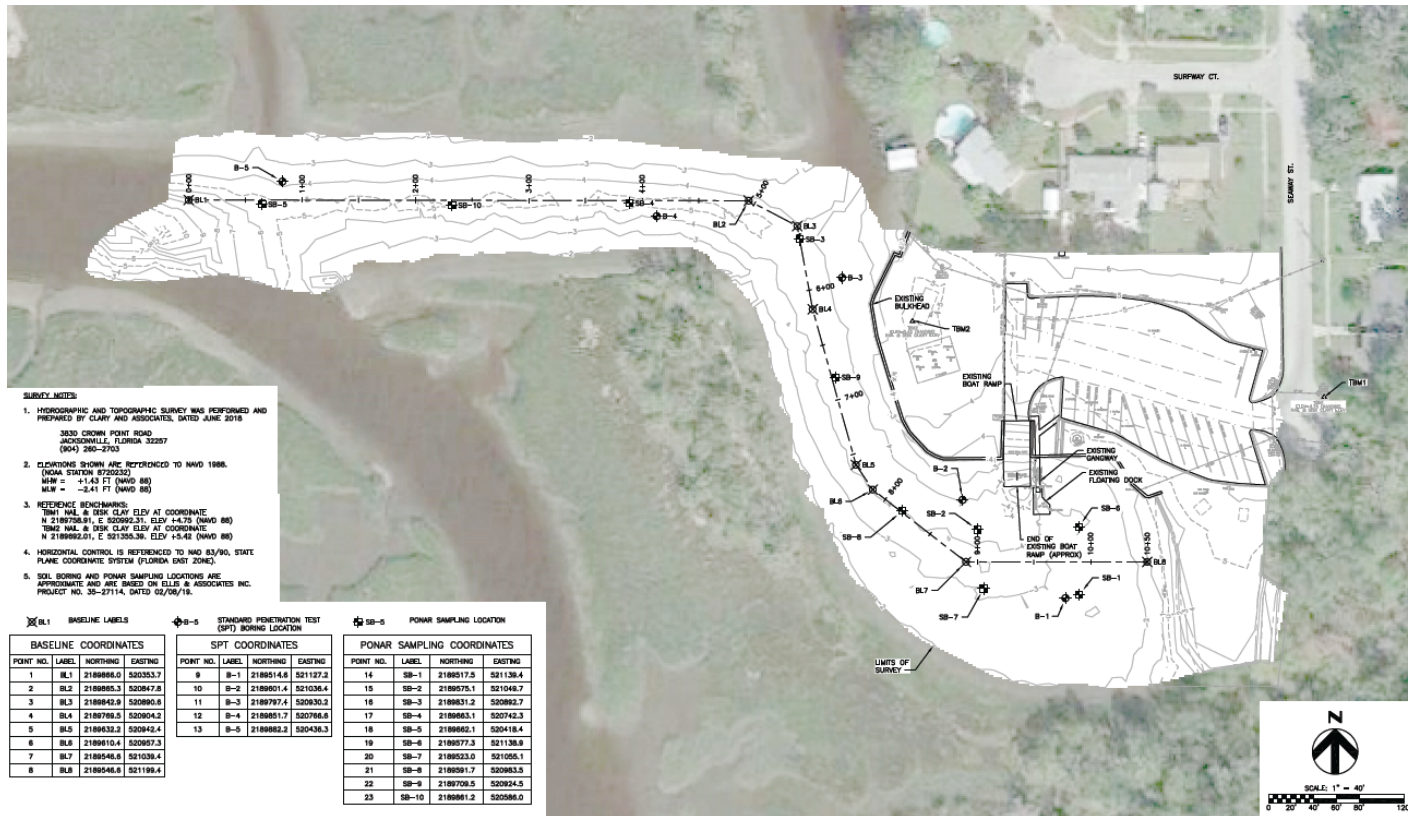
Mandarin Park – Dock Expansion & Adaptive Kayak Launch

- Trailhead complete and open to public.
- Trail connects to NPS trails and north to Betz-Tiger Point Preserve.



Betz-Tiger Point Preserve – New Day-Use Area w/Fishing Pier & Kayak Launch
