

INSTRUCTIONS TO ACCESS THE KINGSOUTEL CROSSING CRA ADVISORY BOARD MEETINGS

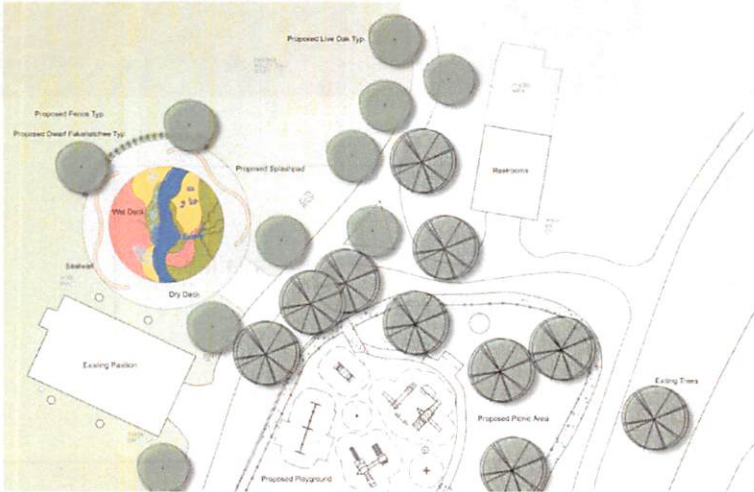

Access to the meetings is as follows:

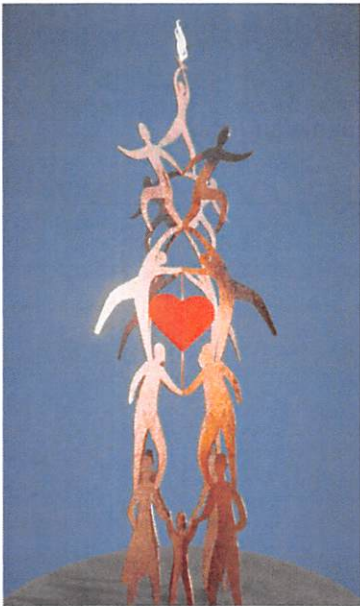
1. Using your browser, go to www.coj.net
2. In the search engine, type Event Calendar
3. The Event Calendar will populate. Click onto it
4. The calendar for the month will populate. Look for KingSoutel Crossing CRA Advisory Board Meeting (They are typically the 4th Thursday of every month unless a special meeting is called). Click onto it.

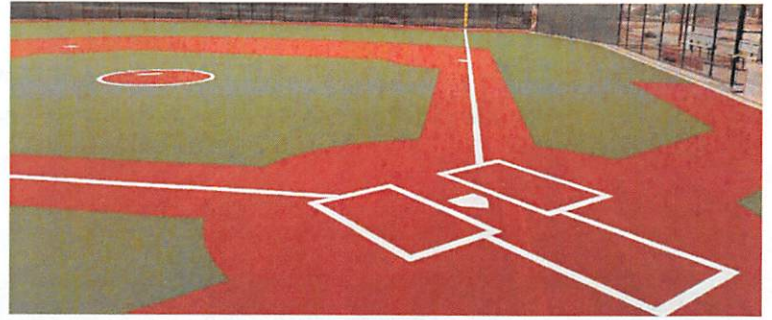
Charles Reese Park
