

Related Development - Southbank

- Existing Dock "B" pilings will be removed and a new dock with 31 slips and fuel pumps will be built in its place.
 - ✓ Provides line of site between fuel pumps and Ship's Store / Marina Office
 - ✓ Provides straight line and shorter run for fuel lines from tank location
- Existing Dock "A" will be removed and considered for replacement in the future by Developer at its cost.



Marina Upgrades

Related Development - Southbank

- City of Jacksonville to enter into the Submerged Land Lease and own all improvements
- Transient dockage slips will continue to be offered to the public during the term of this agreement.
 - ✓ 31 Slips total
 - ✓ 11 long term (no liveaboard)
 - ✓ 10 Transient up to 48 hours
 - ✓ 10 Transient up to 4 hours
- City to fund \$1,143,807 in marina improvements



Fuel Tank Relocation

Related Development - Southbank

- Approximate current location of the <u>underground</u>fuel tanks
- B Approximate *relocation* of the <u>above ground</u> fuel tanks
 - √ Improves resiliency
 - ✓ Improves access
 - ✓ Landscaping in this area subject to COJ design and may not be as shown
- C Location of the Ship's Store / Marina Office




Ship's Store / Marina Office

Related Development - Southbank

Ship's Store / Marina Office

- ✓ Minimum of 1,000 square feet
- ✓ Offers Ice, Snacks, Sundries
- ✓ Open/Staffed 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day, minimum
- ✓ Bathroom for boaters during operating hours
- ✓ Ship's Store and Marina to be operated by Related Group under a negotiated operating agreement with COJ – DIA





St. Johns Marina Hammerhead Boat Ramp Access Option




- Improvements coordinated with COJ Public Works
- Boat Ramp access and parking to be redesigned by COJ
- Access is expected to be through the FDOT parking lot located underneath the Acosta Bridge
- Pad located in top left corner under consideration as a future site for a fish camp style restaurant similar in size and offerings to Safe Harbor, located at the boat ramp adjacent to Beach Marine on Beach Boulevard
- DIA to fund \$1,650,380 for parking lot, boater access, and fuel tank relocation


Acosta Bridge
