MHOP Mental Health Offender Program 9 Month Pilot Report

MHOP (Mental Health Offender Program) is a 9-month pilot program to serve 20 participants in response to the burden that mentally ill offenders place on the criminal justice system and the Pre-Trial Detention Facility through numerous repeated misdemeanor arrests.

MHOP is championed by Chief Judge Mark Mahon and Councilman Ronald Salem through a partnership with the City of Jacksonville, State Attorney's Office, Public Defender's Office, Jacksonville Sheriff's Office and the Sulzbacher Center.

The primary goal of MHOP is to break the cycle of repeated misdemeanor arrests for mentally ill individuals and provide them the behavioral health and all other wrap-around support they need to successfully treat their mental illness and reintegrate back into the community.

During the first few months of MHOP, we discovered that we were serving the most acute and severely affected individuals with mental illness in our community. These MHOP participants were not only living their lives not stabilized for their own safety and well-being, but this instability affects the community in Duval County itself.

At the conclusion of the Pilot, there were 15 individuals that are active MHOP participants and 4 of those participants successfully graduated from MHOP.

The number one individual on the participant list was arrested 97 times since 2017 and 25 times in 2020. This person just happened to be the first participant in MHOP and has successfully transitioned to an Assisted Living Facility.

There are currently 3 individuals that are in the Orientation Phase for consideration for entering MHOP.

There were also 4 MHOP Participants suspended from participation in MHOP and 1 MHOP Participant passed away while participating in MHOP.

Working with the Sulzbacher SOAR processor:

73.3% (11 participants) are now actively receiving benefits.

26.7% (4 participants) are pending benefits and back pay has been applied for.

6.7% had Housing

13.3% pending Permanent Housing







2017 - 2020 MHOP Participant Days In Jail
Prior to MHOP*


