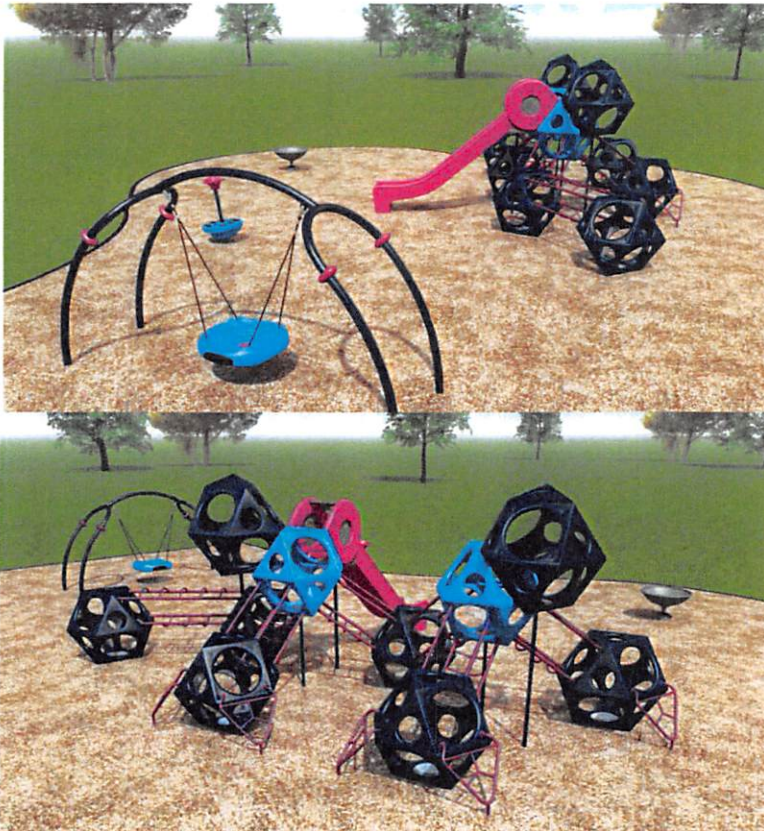

## 2022 Summer Camp Voucher Information Sheet

All voucher applications must be done online. Online applications will be accepted starting April 18<sup>th</sup> at 12pm. All applications will be compiled on voucher lottery list, Voucher Lottery will be drawn on April 19, 2022, and recipients will receive notification email no later than May 6, 2022. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Once awarded, vouchers may be used as electronic payment when you register for summer camp online. NOTE: Vouchers do not cover the extended care fee. This fee will be required for each participant at time of registration, no exceptions. (Payment can be made online using debit or credit card.)

**What you will need to apply:** (All qualifying documents must be current year)

- Student ID number and last 4 digits of social (both are required)
- Name of School Student Attends
- Household Information
- Current Proof of Qualification
  - Free or Reduce Lunch Approval Letter for Current School Year
  - Student's IEP from their school or a medical professional with current date (school year).
  - McKay Scholarship, Children's First Scholarship, or Step Up for Students Scholarship for this school year
  - Family Income at or below 185% of the Federal Poverty Level

185% of Federal Poverty Guidelines
