






### **National Partners**

#### Miami

- Dedicated revenue source
- Community-wide work that has evolved over 25 years

#### Minneapolis

- Housing-focused targeted goal
- COVID funding is primary source

#### Atlanta

- \$25 million bond matched by philanthropy
- Creation of 200+ PSH units and 2,000+ affordable units

- Targeted measurable outcome goals






