




Proposed Boardwalk w/Fishing Platforms




The Amateur and Leisure sports industry accounts for the bulk of total non-resident visitors associated with the Florida Sports Industry. These six segments generate the largest economic footprint of the survey at \$43.4 billion and 443,000 jobs.









