WHEREAS, a dangerous blind spot exists for waterway users approaching Cesery Bridge from both the east and the west; and

WHEREAS, vessels sometimes approach and travel under the Cesery Bridge at higher than ordinary speeds, presenting a danger within the narrow flow channel; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has a process pursuant to Section 327.46, Florida Statutes, by which a local government can establish a "boating-restricted area" to restrict vessel speeds to protect the safety of the public; and

WHEREAS, Section 327.46(1)(b)(2), F.S. provides that such a boating-restricted area may be established within 300 feet of any bridge span presenting a vertical clearance of less than 25 feet or a horizontal clearance of less than 100 feet; and

WHEREAS, the Cesery Bridge has both a vertical clearance of less than 25 feet and a horizontal clearance of less than 100 feet; and

WHEREAS, Board approval by the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission ("FWC") is not required for ordinances adopted pursuant to Section 327.46(1)(b), F.S., however the regulatory markers indicating the extent of the boating-restricted area must be permitted by FWC pursuant to Section 327.41, F.S. and Rule 68D-23, Florida Administrative Code; and WHEREAS, FWC does not provide the markers or dictate the type of marker, whether a fixed piling with attached signs or a buoy anchored to the river bottom, so the decision as to the entity responsible for the cost of the placement and maintenance of the markers is left to the City; and WHEREAS, there are boating areas, spanning between the Arlington Expressway and Beach Boulevard, though not qualifying as "boatingrestricted areas" pursuant to Section 327.46(1)(b), F.S., are navigated by low-speed waterway users (e.g., rowers, kayakers) in need of protection from speeding vessels, now therefore BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2022-2023 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b): (The account is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this reference.) (a) Appropriated from: See Exhibit 1 \$ (b) Appropriated to: See Exhibit 1 (c) **Explanation of the appropriation** - The funding above is to provide \$ from to for the placement

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of "Slow Speed/Minimum Wake" signs in the Arlington River to notify

boaters that a boating-restricted area has been created, and to place

non-regulatory signs in the Arlington River to notify boaters of the presence of low-speed waterway users in the signage areas.

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Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this appropriation is to permit, construct or purchase, and install signs notifying the boating public of the creation of the Cesery Bridge boating-restricted area pursuant to Section 327.46(1)(b)(2), Florida Statutes. This boatingrestricted area will require boaters to operate their vessels at "Slow Speed Minimum Wake" within the area. The purpose of this appropriation is to also permit, construct or purchase, and install non-regulatory signs notifying boaters of low-speed waterway users in certain areas of the Arlington River where such users can be expected. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 110.413, Ordinance Code, funds may be distributed by the Director of Finance and Administration for purposes set forth in this ordinance upon written request from the Director of Parks, Recreation and Community Services, or his designee. To the extent the cost(s) is defrayed by other entities, the amount appropriated herein shall remain in the and be available for future appropriation. Any funds not utilized for this purpose shall be returned to the source of funding.

Section 3. Amending Section 614.132 (Regulations on operation of boats), Chapter 614 (Public Order and Safety). Section 614.132 (Regulations on operation of boats), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

### CHAPTER 614 - PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY

\* \* \*

Sec. 614.132 - Regulations on operation of boats.

\* \* \*

(c) The following is hereby designated as slow speed minimum wake zone within the waters of Duval County:

\* \* \*

(10) Within 100 yards (300 feet) on both sides of the Cesery Bridge on Cesery Blvd., located at Lat. 30°19'22" N/ Long., 81°35'51" W, from shore to shore.

Section 4. Design and Implementation. To ensure slow speeds within the boating-restricted area established in the waters from shore to shore, the Parks Department, in consultation with FWC, and other interested city, state or federal agencies or departments, shall design and obtain necessary permits to install the required number of signs, suitably worded, at appropriate places to alert the boating public about the area. The Parks Department shall also implement the design for the placement of the signs and may solicit funds or in-kind assistance from such agencies and departments to help defray some or all of the cost of permitting, acquiring and installing the signs.

Section 5. Oversight. Oversight of the professional services portion of this effort and the implementation of the design will be conducted by the Parks Department.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.




