Chairwoman Pittman convened the meeting and the attendees introduced themselves for the record.

Presentation on Procurement Bill 2023-20

Deputy General Counsel Lawsikia Hodges gave a brief overview of the background of the bill and the plan for multiple presentations on various facets of the large and complex ordinance over the course of 3 committee meetings. She noted that "central services" (including procurement, fleet management, data processing, personnel and legal services) were a fundamental feature of the consolidation movement in the mid-1960s in order to improve efficiency and accountability. The pending bill deals with topics such as automation and technology in procurement processes, updating outdated provisions, addition of transparency and ethics, improving efficiency, etc. Part 1 revises general regulations and guiding principles; Part 2 combines the current 3 procurement award committees into a single Jacksonville Procurement Awards Committee and changes the membership to avoid Government in the Sunshine difficulties. Language regarding procurement policies and procedures will be removed from the Ordinance Code and placed in an administrative manual. An informal procurement process for lower value procurements is being added. Ms. Hodges said she is ready and willing to work with council members on any ideas for amendments to the ordinance as proposed. Several council members have already expressed an interest in changing provisions regarding the JSEB ombudsman position.

Chairwoman Pittman said that after the 2023-20 presentations are completed after the next several meetings, the committee will hear from invited speakers from the Public Works, Parks and Recreation, and other departments.
