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


Jails and Mental Health

- 60-80% of MH persons have a co-occurring substance abuse issue





Veterans

Therapeutic Community

- Approximately 7% of jail populations are veterans
- Veterans in jail are likely to be older and more likely to be incarcerated for violent sexual offenses
- Justice involved veterans have a mental health (67%) or substance use disorder (52%) or both (44%)
- Veterans Reentry Search Service (VRSS) identifies veterans in inmate populations
- VA's Veteran Justice Outreach (VJO) staff visit the unit 2-3 days a week
- Programs includes substance abuse treatment, cognitive behavioral therapies, social skills, and resume writing
- Reduced incidents and reduced recidivism

RAPID RESOURCE CENTER (RRC)

WHAT IS THE RAPID RESOURCE CENTER?


In 2021, the Franklin County Office of Justice Policy and Programs launched the Rapid Resource Center (RRC).

The RRC is located in a non-confined section of the Franklin County Corrections Center and serves as a one-stop reentry and fast-track to treatment hub, designed to increase access by justice involved individuals to transition planning, treatment referral linkage, harm reduction education, and other identified supportive services that will support a positive community re-integration and reduce the likelihood of overdose deaths and recidivism.





- Normalized furnishings and finishes.
- Use of cool colors (blues and greens).
- Promote opportunities for choice while maintaining security.

- Natural materials and elements that reflect the environment.
















