Noticed Meeting on the Riverside Avenue Drainage Study MINUTES November 30, 2023

- 1) Welcome and Introductions CM Matt Carlucci CM Matt Carlucci called the meeting to order and asked that CM Jimmy Peluso also introduce the guests.
 - 2) Recap of Immediate Past Actions

CM Jimmy Peluso

CM Jimmy Peluso emphasized the critical nature of flooding issues in Riverside. He thanked attendees and acknowledged the presence of key individuals like Anne Coglianese, the Chief Resilience Officer. The discussion involved a recap of past efforts and developments leading to the current situation, highlighting the collaborative work and progress made in addressing Riverside's flooding challenges.
