**Purpose**

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss updates on the Jammes Road Park project and address community concerns about park amenities, timelines, and public access.

**Introduction & Opening Comments**

The meeting was called to order by Councilman Johnson, who welcomed attendees and provided an overview of the meeting's agenda. He emphasized the importance of the Jammes Road Park project in enhancing community well-being and improving recreational facilities for District 14 residents.
