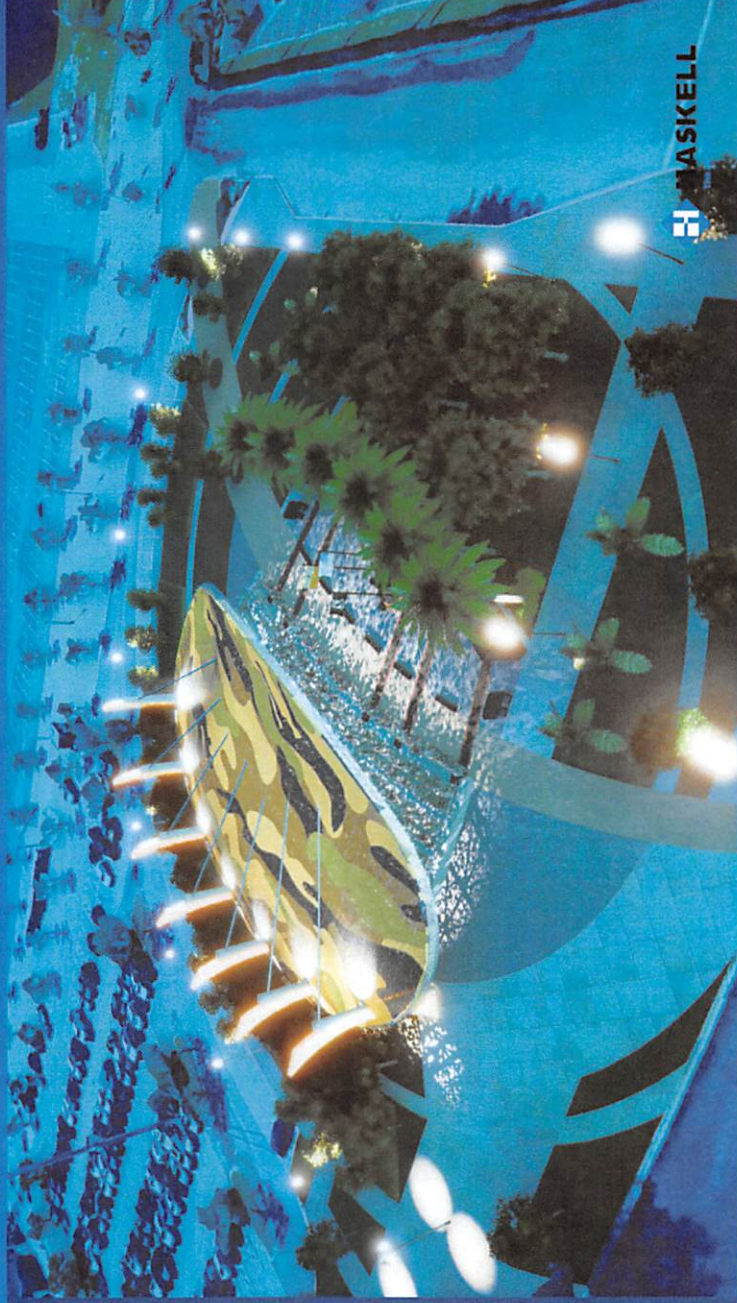

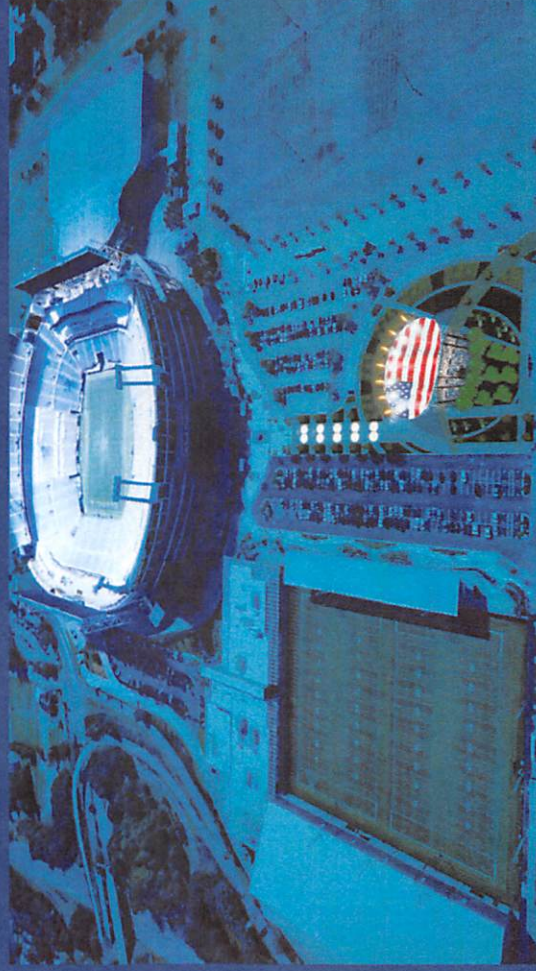

Video of programmable mesh lighting option

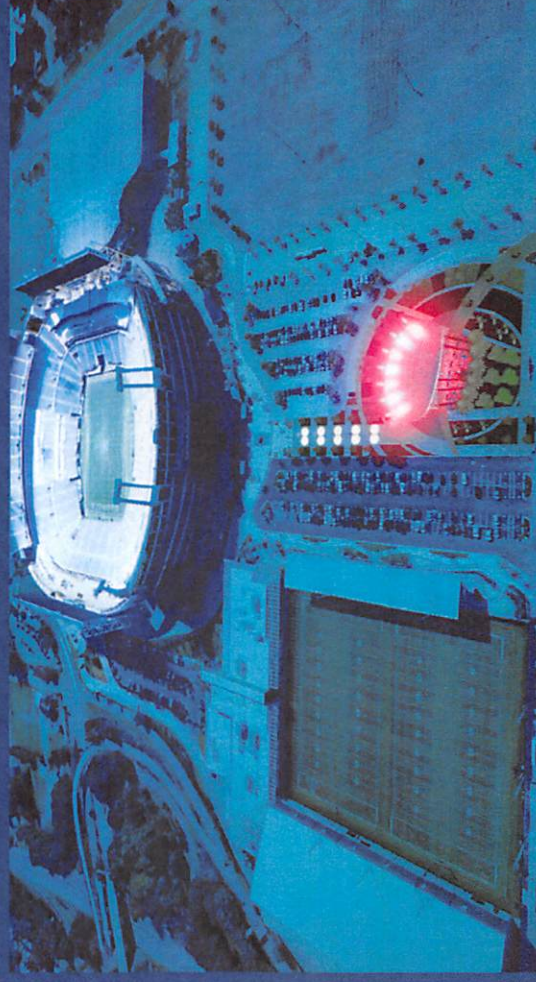

Shade Structure



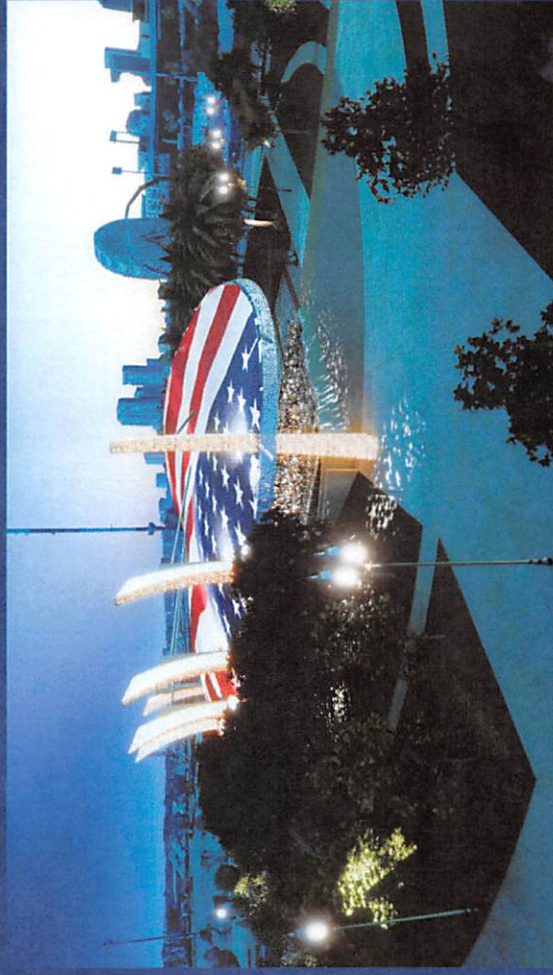

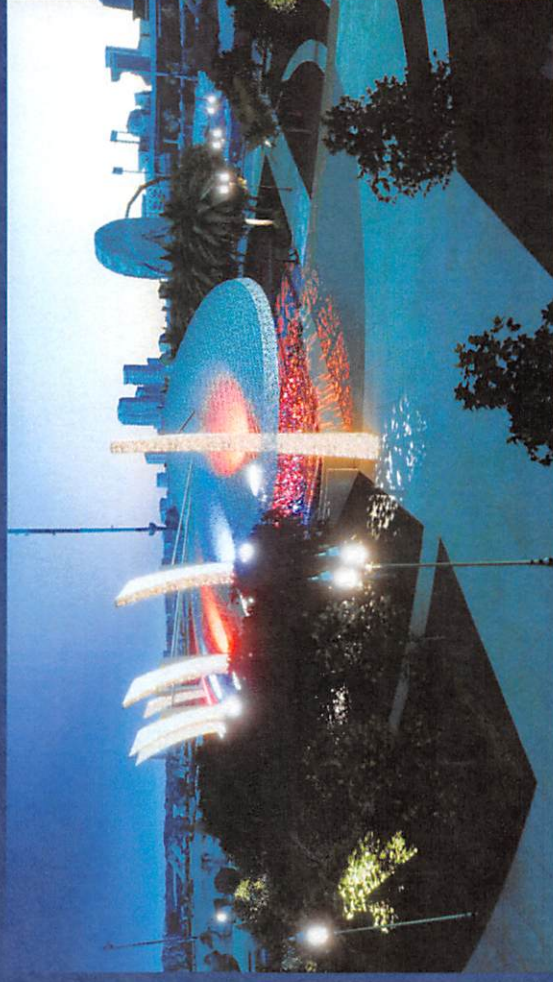

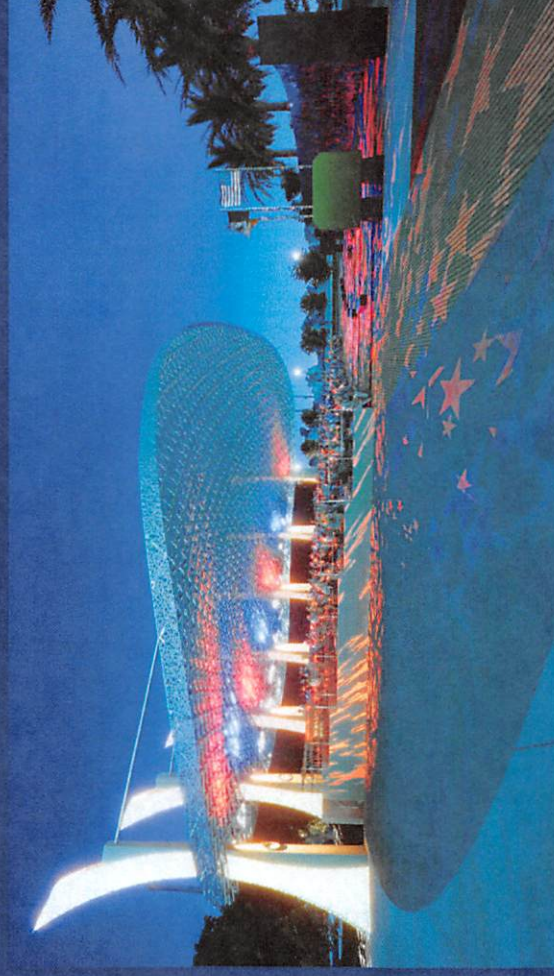

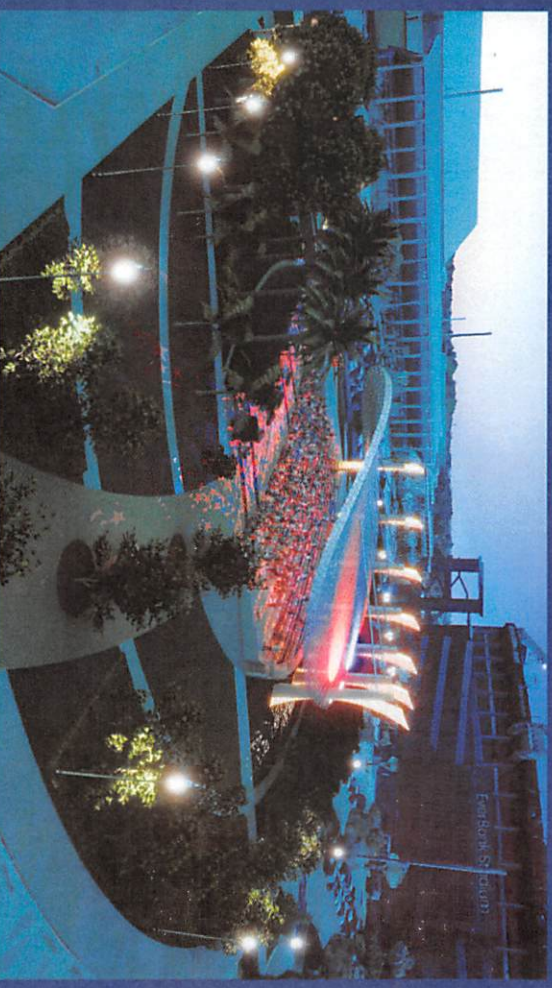

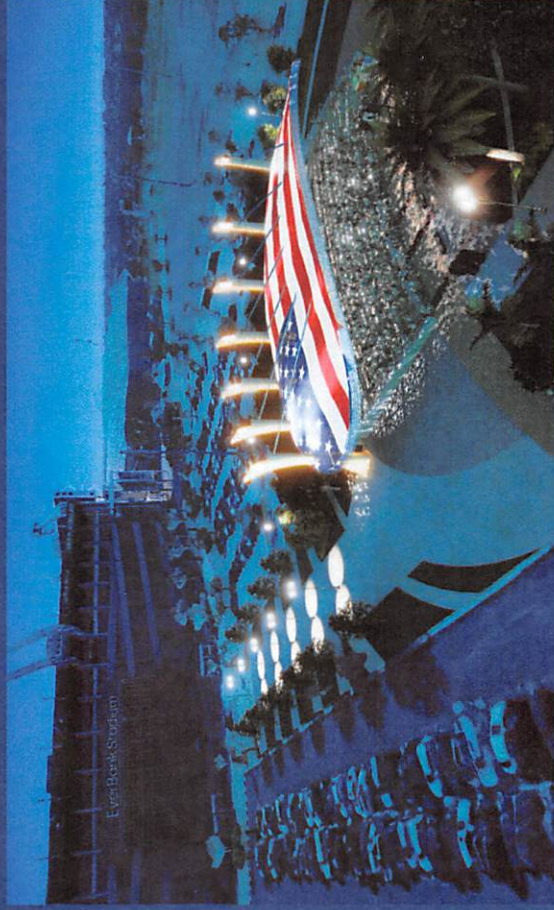

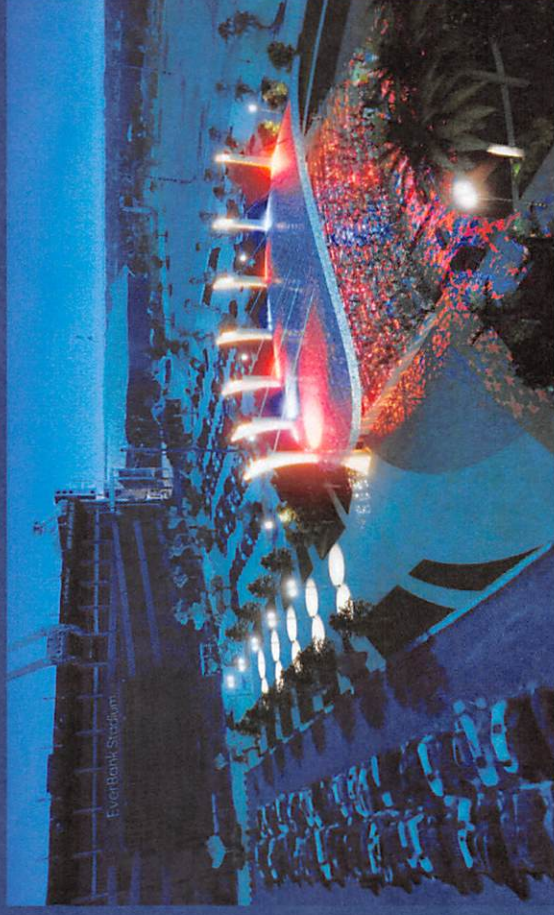
Pillar-mounted spotlight Option

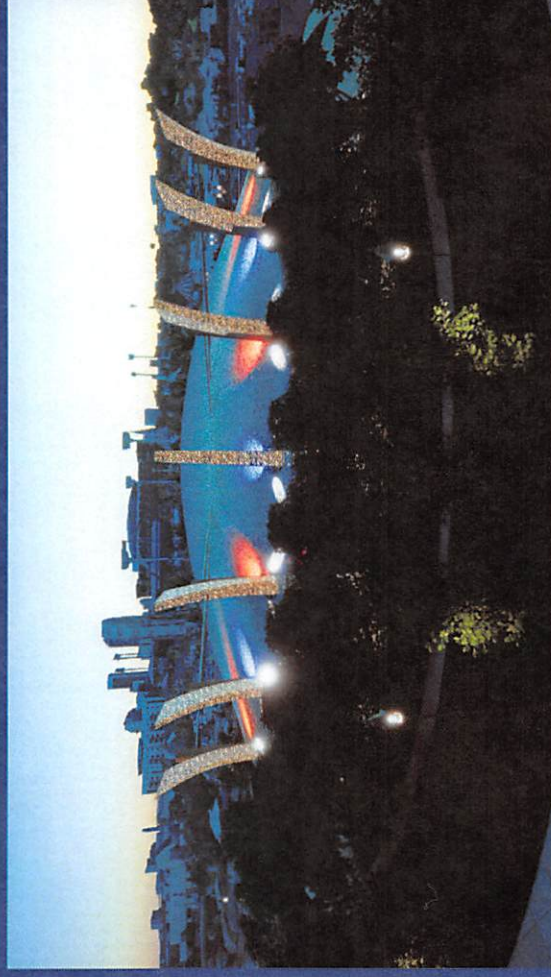

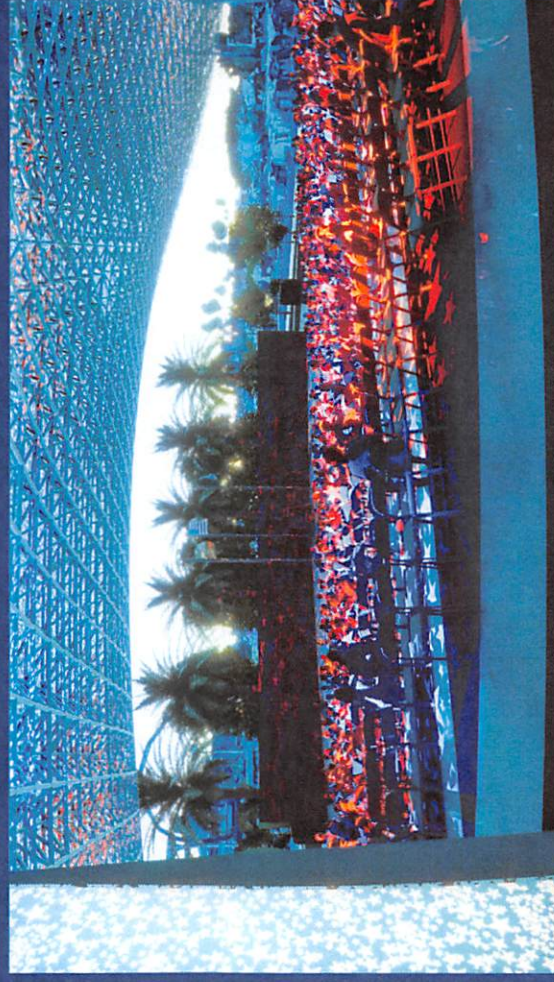

Perforated Star Pattern Provides Dappled Light and Shade



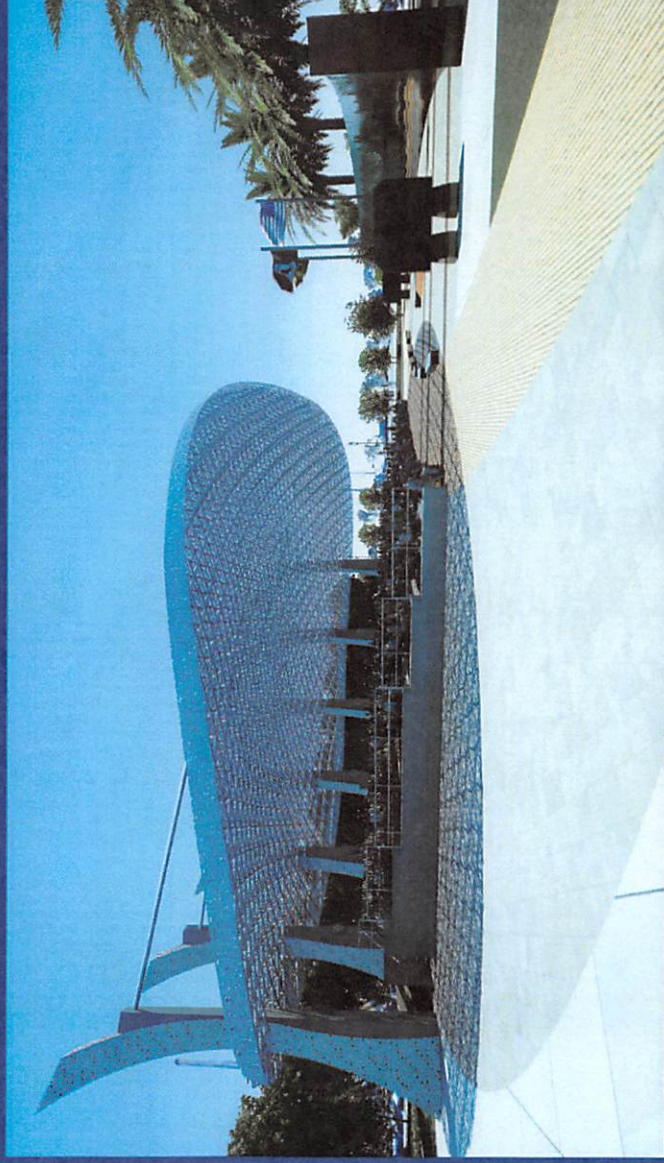
