DOWNTOWN SERVICES





Right of Way & Stormwater Maintenance

- Maintains all city-owned streets, sidewalks, and drainage facilities
- Pothole patching and resurfacing
- Daily Street Sweeping – prior to 7am (M-F)
- Drainage pipes and inlets - Clean, clear, and repair
- Operate and maintain one downtown stormwater pump station
- Install and repair sidewalks and curbs



Mowing & Landscape Maintenance

- Grass, Trees, Other Vegetation, Irrigation
- Rights of Way, Public Buildings, Retention Ponds, Park Grounds
- Downtown: **Weekly** Landscape and Maintenance Services – 3 JSEB firms
Mowing, Edging, Trimming, Blowing / Sweeping, Weed Control, Litter Control and upkeep of ornamental plant beds
 - All Parks with some exclusions such as Corkscrew, SJR Park, Artist Walk
 - Does not include pressure washing
- **Annual** Mulching of landscape beds and open tree wells
- **Annual** pruning of date palms



Public Buildings

- Security, Custodial, and Maintenance
- Over 4M SF of City-owned buildings Downtown such as City Hall, Ed Ball, Libraries, Courthouse
- Paying utilities (water / electric) for all city facilities, parks, and rights-of-way (except streetlights and traffic signals)
- Types of work:
 - HVAC, Plumbing, Electrical, Carpentry
 - Construction and renovations
 - Fire Protection and life safety
 - Roof repair replacement



Traffic Engineering

- Installs, Maintains, Designs and Regulates:
- Street Markings, Signs, Signals, and other traffic control devices on City-owned roadways
- Maintains traffic signals on state/federal arterial roads such as State Street, Union Street, Main Street, and Beaver Street
 - FDOT compensates the City for this Activity
- Approves Maintenance of Traffic / road closures for construction and special events



Engineering & Construction Management

- Plans, designs, and oversees construction of city projects, such as:
- Buildings, Roadways, Drainage Improvements, Parks
- Fire Stations
- Surveying and Topographical Office



Office of Administrative Svcs Solid Waste Division

- Parks Department collects trash and litter within City Parks
- Solid Waste Division collects trash in specified downtown collection area and within litter receptacles along downtown streets
- Collections six nights per week
- Litter Receptacles emptied at least every other day. If observed full or overflowing, may be emptied daily
- Downtown Ambassadors / Downtown Vision collect stray litter but not containers
