



Recreation and Community Programming Overview

The City of Jacksonville consists of a diverse network of over 400 recreational parks and facilities. Including within these parks are over 600 athletic fields and courts.

Together these amenities promote healthy, active lifestyles, and provide vibrant spaces for community engagement and recreation.

Athletic Associations

Partnering with more than **42 athletic associations**

Allows the city to enhance programming, increase participation, and improve facility maintenance. These collaborations bring specialized expertise, innovative programs, and diverse opportunities for residents of all ages.

This partnership is done through an RFP process through the City's procurement division and comes with minimum eligibility requirements and a contract term length of 3 years with option of (2) three-year renewals.

Eligibility Requirements include:

- Business licenses
- Liability insurance
- 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(4) company by the State of Florida.
- Established, operating, and experienced offering the specific programming related to the Scope of Services for a minimum of two (2) years.





Athletic Associations

Athletic Associations responsibility include:

- Minor repair and maintenance of City building(s)
- Cleaning of all buildings and facilities within contract.
- Restroom cleaning and supplies while in season.
- Providing chairs, tables and other furniture, and equipment.
- Provide trash removal of all field and facilities.
- Phone, Internet, and Alarm Monitoring
- Supplement mowing of athletic fields.
- Supplement fertilization and pesticide.
- Prepare and mark fields for games.
- Provide future development, enhancements, and improvements for athletic fields/facilities with prior approval from the Department.
- Field and facility improvements to enhance programs

City of Jacksonville responsibility include:

- Payment of water, sewer, and electric utilities
- New and continued maintenance and repairs of all major systems, structure of the building, and parking lot.
- Field Lighting repairs
- Sidewalk and path repairs
- Repairs to electrical and plumbing
- Irrigation repairs
- Supple of on-site dumpster as needed
- Repair and replacement of doors, windows, and roof.
- Support of turf management through overseeding and fertilization.
- HVAC system repair and maintenance
- Fence and sports netting repair and maintenance






Field Maintenance & Operations

- Regular lawn mowing and landscaping
- Irrigation system management and repairs
- Field marking and line repainting
- Turf aeration, fertilization, and reseeding
- Pest and Weed Control
- Equipment maintenance (mowers, field draggers, etc.)
- Bleacher and seating area upkeep
- Lighting system inspection and repairs
- Scoreboard and electronic display maintenance
- Trash disposal
- Repair of fencing and netting
- Concession stand upkeep and cleaning
- Paint and touch-up work
