As required by Ordinance 664.703, attached is the annual report of the Parks Partnership Program for Fiscal Year 2019.

Please see the milestones and achievements for FY 2019, the second full year, of the Parks Partnership Program.

### FY 2019: Milestones and Achievements

- The number of program participants more than doubled in FY 2019.
- Half of participating donors request recognition. A high number of participating donors donated to improve parks without recognition.
- A creative improvement in FY 2019 is an artist's forest rendering painted on four sides of a formerly gray building on the Southbank Riverwalk with funds donated by the Downtown Dwellers Association.
- The partnership program received \$100,000 reoccurring donation for the naming rights of Fort Family Regional Park at Baymeadows.
- In FY 2019, aside from the reoccurring donation to Fort Family Regional Park, the second highest donation to a single park is \$12,000 to Ed Austin Regional Park. Neighbors purchased four new park benches which will be installed on the park's asphalt trail.
