






The East Coast Greenway


- The East Coast Greenway Project began in 1991 as a means to create a coastal greenway trail linking the major cities of the Atlantic Coast of the U.S.
- The project focused on creating the Nation's longest connected biking and walking route, at nearly 3000 miles.





Florida ECG Overview


• Connected by the St. John's River Ferry, the Greenway continues through Duval County, connecting our beaches.






A1A Ocean Islands Trail

- Promoting tourism and economic development for Nassau and Duval counties.






Core 2 Coast Loop
