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RESOLUTION 2021-

A RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING THE STATE TO ALLOW LOCAL GOVERNMENTS TO WAIVE THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 336.025 AND 336.021, FLORIDA LOCAL ALLOW STATUTES, TO GOVERNMENTS ABILITY TO SUSPEND COLLECTION OF LOCAL OPTION GAS TAXES IF THE STATE SUSPENDS THE STATE GAS TAX FOR A PERIOD OF TIME THAT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE STATE'S SUSPENSION; OFFERING FINDINGS AND STATEMENTS OF FACT; ADDITIONAL APPROVAL REQUIRED TO AND AUTHORIZATION EXECUTE DOCUMENTS RELATED TO THE WAIVER OF STATUTES TO SUSPEND COLLECTION OF THE LOGT AND TRANSFER OF FUNDS TO PREVENT FUNDING LAPSE; DIRECTION TO FORWARD TO THEFLORIDA LEGISLATURE, THE DUVAL LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in May 2021, the City Council approved an extension to the current six-cent local option gas tax and levied a new five-cent local option gas tax and a one-cent local option gas tax in Ordinance 2021-223-E (with the new five-cent and one-cent taxes together referred to herein as the "LOGT"); and

WHEREAS, the City is in the process of implementing the additional LOGT and executing interlocal agreements with the municipal corporations within Duval County to begin collection and disbursement of the LOGT on January 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, in recent months following economic conditions related to the COVID-19 pandemic and supply chain issues affecting the sale and delivery of products nationally and internationally, the price of gasoline at the pump has increased in a short period of time; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Florida recently announced that he would propose to temporarily reduce the 26.5-cent per gallon state gas tax imposed pursuant to Chapter 336, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the suspension of the state gas tax does not negate collection of other gas taxes, including the federal gas taxes imposed at 18.4 cents a gallon and the local option gas tax totaling 12 cents per gallon (of which 6-cents for LOGT were approved in Ordinance 2021-223-E); and

WHEREAS, if the Legislature and/or the Governor is successful in temporarily suspending the state gas tax, the Council believes that the State should take action to allow waiver of provisions of Sections 336.025 (pertaining to the 5-cent tax) and 336.021 (pertaining to the 9th cent tax), Florida Statutes, pertaining to collection of local option gas taxes so that local governments have the ability to also temporarily suspend the collection of local option gas taxes for a time consistent with the suspension of the state gas taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Council respectfully requests that if the Legislature and/or the Governor takes action to suspend collection of the state gas tax upon the residents of Florida that they also put in place a mechanism for local governments to waive the process outlined in Sections 336.025 (pertaining to the 5-cent tax) and 336.021 (pertaining to the 9th cent tax), Florida Statutes, and have the ability to do the same to suspend local option gas taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that it is a legitimate public purpose for the City of Jacksonville to suspend the 6-cent LOGT for a period of time consistent with the State's proposed suspension of the state gas tax to alleviate some of the hardship that rising gas prices have taken on the citizens of Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, since the Legislature and/or the Governor may act to suspend the State gas tax as soon as the next several months and the Council would like to communicate its intent to authorize suspension of the LOGT collection, if the State allows waiver of the statutory provisions as to collection, as swiftly as possible to align with the State action; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of time, the Council desires to immediately communicate to the State its desire to temporarily suspend LOGT collection if the State takes action to suspend the state gas tax; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Findings and Statement of Intent.

- (a) The above recitals are hereby adopted as the Council's Findings of Fact; and
- (b) It is the intent of the Council to communicate to the State that it supports the State's temporary waiver of provisions of Sections 336.025 (pertaining to the 5-cent tax) and 336.021 (pertaining to the 9th cent tax), Florida Statutes, so that the City of Jacksonville can be authorized to temporarily suspend collection of the LOGT to align with any State action that suspends collection of the state gas tax; and
- (c) It is further the intent of the Council to act swiftly at the local level to authorize the City of Jacksonville to take the necessary steps to immediately suspend collection of the LOGT if the State authorizes waiver of the statutory provisions regarding collection for local government gas taxes.

Encouraging the State Legislature and/or the Section 2. Governor, as applicable, to waive certain statutory provisions to allow local governments to suspend collection of local option gas taxes for a period of time consistent with the State suspension of collection of state gas taxes. Upon approval by the Legislature or the Governor, as applicable, of a temporary suspension of the collection of state gas taxes, the Council believes that local governments should have the ability to waive the provisions of Sections 336.025 (pertaining to the 5-cent tax) and 336.021 (pertaining to the 9th cent tax), Florida Statutes, to allow local governments the option to temporarily suspend the collection of the local option gas taxes. Therefore, the Council would respectfully encourage and request that if the State takes action to suspend collection of the state gas tax upon the residents of Florida that it also puts in place a mechanism for the waiver of Sections 336.025 (pertaining to the 5-cent tax) and 336.021 (pertaining to the 9th cent tax), Florida Statutes, and provisions regarding collection of the local option gas taxes consistent with the suspension of collection of state gas taxes.

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Section 3. Additional approval and authorization required to execute documents related to the temporary suspension of the local option gas tax and transfer of funds to prevent lapse in funding. Should the State offer a mechanism to waive the provisions of Sections 336.025 (pertaining to the 5-cent tax) and 336.021 (pertaining to the 9th cent tax), Florida Statutes, to allow for local governments' suspension of collection of the local option gas tax consistent with suspension of the state gas tax, the Council hereby states its intent to file emergency legislation to authorize the City to execute and deliver any such documents necessary to effectuate a temporary suspension of the LOGT consistent with State suspension of state gas tax, and to authorize the appropriation of

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funding to prevent any lapses in funding from budgeted LOGT fund sources.

Section 4. Directing the forwarding to State Governor and Legislature, the Duval Legislative Delegation, and the Florida Department of Revenue. The Legislative Services Division is directed to send an electronic copy of this Ordinance upon enactment to the Governor, the Senate President and the Speaker of the House of the Florida Legislature, the members of the Duval Legislative Delegation, and the Florida Department of Revenue.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
