Office of General Counsel amendments:

- 1) Section 21.04(b) (powers) require real estate rules and procedures to also be published on JEA's website
- 2) Section 21.04(b) (powers/real estate) CM Salem real estate inquiry regarding JEA's disposition of property that it no longer uses to other City agencies
- 3) Section 21.04(p), 21.08 (employment matters), 21.09 (procurement matters) require all reports to also be published on JEA's website
- 4) Section 21.08(e) (employment matters) reference JEA's existing 401(a) defined contribution plan
- 5) Section 21.08(c) (employment matters) review definition of "compensation" and other provisions regarding JEA's ability to create additional pension plans (e.g., PFPF recent court order CM Cumber TEU comments)

Council Auditor amendments:

- 6) Section 21.04(y) (advertisements/promotions) add a date certain as to when the JEA is required to provide a promotional list to the council auditors
- 7) Section 21.04(ff) (powers) add a cross-reference to Section 21.11(d) to ensure the 1% calculation applies to the net change
- 8) Section 21.08(e) (employment mattes) add a timeframe regarding the deferred compensation report to the council auditors
- 9) Section 21.08(f) (employment matters)— add a timeframe regarding the employee bonus program report to the council auditors
- 10) Section 21.11(a) (privatization) change the October 1, 2020 date to September 30, 2020 to reflect the date of their financial statements. Also, add "audited" to financial statements
- 11) Section 21.11(d) (privatization) clarify that JEA is permitted to comply with the existing terms and conditions of the current interlocal agreement only without council or referendum approval
- 12) CM Salem's comment relative to "City Council of the City of Jacksonville" vs "Council" (same as to council auditor) throughout Article 21 Section 3 of the bill (referendum) strike as it is no longer needed
