SUBJECT: Local Option Gas Tax (LOGT) 2021-0223 and Septic Tank 2021-0235 Legislation Timeline

This memorandum is provided to update you regarding the Local Option Gas Tax (LOGT) and Septic Tank Legislation and timeline.

Now that bills 2021-0223 and 2021-0235 have been filed, the bills will have -their first readings on, April 27th, 2021, at Council. I have assigned both legislations specifically to the Committee of the Whole so that all Council Members can be equally informed and be able to ask questions and voice any concerns.

To ensure that all questions can be answered thoroughly and comprehensively, the City's Administration, Jacksonville Transportation Authority, Jacksonville Electric Authority, Representatives - Office of General Counsel, and Council Auditor will be invited to attend a noticed meeting of the Committee of the Whole on April 29th, 2021 at 9:00am, and afforded time on the agenda for the meeting to be in the Council Chamber, with hybrid format for the public.

There will be a public hearing at the regular Council meeting on May 11th, 2021 and the bills will be heard by the Committee of the Whole on Wednesday, May 12th, 2021 at 2:00pm. The Committee of the Whole will make its recommendation in the form of a committee report. A special City Council meeting shall be noticed immediately following the Committee of the Whole to take final action should the Committee of the Whole conclude its work and make its recommendations.
