








9-1-1 Calls for Overdose by Day




9-1-1 Calls for Overdose by Week




Calls for Overdose Last Day




Calls for Overdose Last 7 Days




Calls for Overdose Since March 13

Definitions: **Dispatched as Overdose** = a 9-1-1 call was received in which the caller stated that the victim was suffering from a known or suspected overdose. **Narcain Doses Given** = the count of Narcan administered. **Opioid-Related Overdose** = incidents in which the on scene paramedic determined the incident was a known or suspected overdose event AND Narcan was administered. Each of these events are independent of the other and are not mutually exclusive. A 9-1-1 Call Received as overdose and/or Narcan administration does not necessarily confirm an overdose or opioid use.
