FY 2020: Milestones and Achievements

- In the three years this program has been operational, the Department has received a total of: \$475,600, of private enhancement to Jacksonville's parks.
- The enhancements this year were varied, including park benches, a picnic table, a water fountain, a shade structure, and upgrades to Fort Family Regional Park at Baymeadows.
- The partnership program received \$100,000 reoccurring donation for the naming rights of Fort Family Regional Park at Baymeadows.
