Methodology

The U.S. Census does not track data by City Council District. To obtain data for each Council District, the individual Census Tracts within each District had to be identified. Some Census Tracts are housed within multiple Council Districts. For these tracts, the data is halved to approximate accuracy. Data was then gathered for each Census Tract within a district and tallied. The totals and averages of the data from all of the Census Tracts within a district is used to represent the Council District totals on the chart below.

Table Breakdown and Notes

The table below houses the compiled data totals for each of the 14 City Council Districts. There is a column for the estimated total population for each district, an estimated number of the population within the district for whom poverty status has been determined, and the numerical average of the population for whom poverty status has been determined. Highlighted are the Council Districts with a population of 20% or higher for whom poverty status has been determined. County totals are included for comparative purposes.

U.S. Census Poverty Status Determination

Following the Office of Management and Budget's (OMB) Statistical Policy Directive 14, the Census Bureau uses a set of money income thresholds that vary by family size and composition to determine who is in poverty. If a family's total income is less than the family's threshold, then that family and every individual in it is considered in poverty. The official poverty thresholds do not vary geographically, but they are updated for inflation using the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U). The official poverty definition uses money income before taxes and does not include capital gains or noncash benefits (such as public housing, Medicaid, and food stamps).
