### **Post-Employment Appeals Committee Annual Report 2020**

In accordance with Jacksonville Ordinance Code section 50.110, the Post-Employment Appeals Committee submits its Annual Report for calendar year 2020.

#### **I. Post-Employment Appeals Committee Members:**

There are no prior or current vacancies on the Post-Employment Appeals Committee.

#### **II. Summary of Post-Employment Committee Purpose and Activities/Meetings**

The Post-Employment Appeals Committee was established by City Council in 2007 to permit City employees and officials to appeal the application of post-employment restrictions pursuant to Jacksonville Ordinance Code section 602.412.

The Post-Employment Appeals Committee met on January 24, 2020 for its only meeting during 2020. The committee convened to consider an appeal for relief from Jacksonville Ethics Code section 602.412 for a potential future employee with the Northeast Florida Healthy Start Coalition. It was determined that the petitioner's potential future employment did not create an ethical conflict of interest and a waiver was granted for the petitioner. The meeting was effective and served the purpose of the enabling legislation.
