

DUVAL COUNTY VALUE ADJUSTMENT BOARD
PROCEDURES FOR CONSIDERING AND ADOPTING
RECOMMENDED DECISIONS OF SPECIAL MAGISTRATES

The function of the Value Adjustment Board (VAB) is to hear appeals from decisions of the Duval County Property Appraiser's Office (PAO).

The VAB will not hold any further *hearings* on the petitions today. However, at the meeting at which Special Magistrate recommendations are considered and adopted, the Board will allow the opportunity for public comment.

Please complete the VAB Clerk Speaker's Request Card and submit it to the VAB Clerk down in front prior to speaking. Guidelines for Speakers are on the back of the Speaker's Request Cards. Comments are limited to three minutes per person, not to exceed three minutes in total per petition. During that time, you may make whatever comments you wish; however, the VAB will ultimately be considering whether the Special Magistrate recommendation complies with applicable law.

After the close of public comments, the VAB will consider and vote on the Special Magistrate recommendations.
